## **TONIGHT'S GAME**

The Dream returns home for Games 2 and 3 (if necessary) after dropping the first game of the series to the Shock 94-89 in Detroit. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:30 pm ET at Gwinnett Arena. The game will be nationally televised on NBA TV.

The Dream jumped out to a 30-16 lead in the first quarter of Game 1 on Wednesday night in Detroit, but the Shock rallied for a 94-89 victory over the Dream in the opener of their Eastern Conference first-round series. Trailing by as many as 13 points midway through the third quarter, the Shock went on a 17-0 run to close out the quarter. Detroit led 90-89 with 16.1 seconds to go and two free throws by reserve Crystal Kelly but the Shock up 92-89 and Dream forward Iziane Castro Marques missed a three-point attempt that would have tied the game.

Deanna Nolan led the Shock to victory with 25 points and Kara Braxton added 16. The Dream was led by Castro Marques with 25 points and seven assists. Rookie Angel McCoughtry added 21 points, eight rebounds and four assists in the loss. Erika de Souza (13 points, seven rebounds) and Sancho Lyttle (11 points, nine rebounds) also finished in double figures for the Dream.

Both teams have been hindered by injuries to key players. Dream starting point guard Shalee Lehning is out for the remainder of the season following surgery on her left shoulder. Lehning suffered the injury (separated shoulder) in the Dream's regular season finale against the Washington Mystics. Forward Chamique Holdsclaw returned to the lineup for the first time since August 20, following arthroscopic knee surgery (right knee). Holdsclaw was limited to 12 minutes, scoring three points in Game 1.

Detroit is still without starting guard Katie Smith (back), who has been out since August 27. Guard Alexis Hornbuckle returned to the lineup after missing the regular season finale (hamstring). The Shock's leading scorer, Deanna Nolan, had to leave the end of Game 1 after collapsing on the court following a foul on the previous possession. Nolan was diagnosed with a concussion following the game but is expected to play Friday.

## **ROSTER CONNECTIONS**

Dream guard Ivory Latta played one season with the Shock as a rookie before being acquired by the Dream in the 2008 Expansion Draft. On the other side of the ball, Shock point guard Nikki Teasley started the first ten games of the year for the Dream before being waived on July 3. Teasley was picked up by the Shock on August 18 and has started seven of 11 games for Detroit. The game will also pit former Georgia teammates Coco Miller (Dream) and Deanna Nolan (Shock) against each other. Miller and Nolan were both first round selections in the 2001 WNBA Draft.

## **REGULAR SEASON SERIES**

The regular season series was marked by physical play, as the Dream and Shock finished as two of the top rebounding teams in the league. Atlanta finished the regular season as the best rebounding team in the league, averaging 37.0 rpg. Detroit was not far behind, in third place with an average of 36.6 rpg. Chamique Holdsclaw was the Dream's most efficient player against the Shock in the regular season, averaging 18.3 points and five rebounds per game against Detroit. Center Erika de Souza averaged a double-double against Detroit, with 13.5 points and 11.3 rebounds per game in the four regular season matchups.



## **NEWS AND NOTES**

### **HOME AWAY FROM HOME**

Due to scheduling conflicts at Philips Arena, the Dream will play its first round home games at Gwinnett Arena in Duluth.

### **BATTLE OF THE BOARDS**

The Dream-Shock matchup will feature two of the top rebounding teams in the league. Atlanta led the league in rebounding with 37.0 rpg but the Shock were not far behind with an average of 36.6 rpg. The Dream gets it done with the inside presence of Erika de Souza (9.1 rpg) and Sancho Lyttle (7.5 rpg) while the Shock rely on the trio of Cheryl Ford (7.4 rpg), Taj McWilliams (6.6 rpg), and Kara Braxton (6.0 rpg). Three of the league's top 10 rebounders will be in action in the series (de Souza- #2, Lyttle- #6, and Ford- #7).

### **A DREAM SEASON**

With 18 wins in the regular season, the Dream more than quadrupled their win total from a year ago and clinched a playoff berth in just the second year of the franchise. The Dream won four games total last season as an expansion team, finishing 4-30. Detroit holds the biggest single-season turnaround. The Shock boasts the biggest improvement in winning percentage, with an increase of 454 percentage points from 2002 (9-23) to 2003 (25-9).

### **CALLING ON ANGEL**

With Chamique Holdsclaw coming back from arthroscopic surgery on her right knee, Angel McCoughtry has been inserted into the starting lineup and has responded. In her playoff debut, McCoughtry recorded 21 points, eight rebounds and four assists. She has scored in double figures in 25 of 35 games. She led all rookies in scoring and steals and finished third in field goal percentage this season.

### **TOP OF THE CLASS**

Guard Angel McCoughtry was named the adidas Rookie of the Month for August. McCoughtry, the top overall pick in the 2009 WNBA Draft, previously earned Rookie of the Month for the month of July. In 10 games, McCoughtry led all rookies and the Dream in points per game (17.3), which placed her among the top 10 in the league. She also led all rookies in steals per game (3.4), and ranked third in rebounds per game (3.4) and assists per game (2.4). McCoughtry scored a career-high 34 points in a 93-87 win over San Antonio. Over the month, she helped the Dream to a 6-4 record and scored in double digits in each game, including three 20+ outings.

### **NOT IN MY HOUSE**

Center Erika de Souza set a career-high with six blocks against Seattle on August 29. Her six blocks also set a Dream franchise record. The previous high was five blocks recorded by Alison Bales last season. In her last five games, de Souza is averaging close to a double-double with 15.2 points and 9.2 rebounds per game.

### **INSTANT OFFENSE**

Iziane Castro Marques has come alive in the second half of the season. Castro Marques has scored in double figures in 21 of her last 23 games. She has recorded two 30+ point performances this season.

### **PUTTING UP POINTS**

The Dream has scored over 90 points ten times this season and has topped the 100 point mark twice. In those games, Atlanta is 9-1. During the regular season, Atlanta averaged 84.8 ppg, which ranked second in the league behind the Phoenix Mercury. Five players average double figures for the Dream—Castro Marques, de Souza, Holdsclaw, Lyttle and McCoughtry.

### **FIRST HALF FORTUNE**

The Dream's first-half performance has been a key indicator of the end result this season. Atlanta is 13-3 in games that they lead at the half (5-13 in games they trail at the half and 0-1 in games tied at the half).

### **ALMOST DOESN'T COUNT**

Of the Dream's 17 losses this season (including playoffs), only four have been double digit losses. Nine of the Dream's 17 losses this season have been by a margin of five points or less. The Dream are 2-7 this season in games decided by four points or less.

### **DYNAMIC DUO**

The Dream has outscored opponents under the basket in 28 out of 35 games this season (includes playoffs) and finished the regular season as the top rebounding team (36.9 rpg). This surge of inside scoring can be attributed to the duo of Sancho Lyttle (13.0 ppg, 7.5 rpg- regular season) and Erika de Souza (11.8 ppg, 9.1 rpg- regular season). Lyttle has eight double-doubles this season and de Souza has eleven. The duo also finished the regular season among league leaders in field goal percentage (de Souza ranked fourth with 52.8% and Lyttle ranked seventh with 50.7%). De Souza finished second in the league in rebounding and Lyttle finished sixth.

### **THE PRICE IS RIGHT**

The Dream acquired guard Armintie Price on August 12 from the Chicago Sky in exchange for guard Tamera Young. Price, a 5-9 guard from the University of Mississippi, appeared in 22 games for the Sky this season, averaging 3.5 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.2 assists. Now in her third year in the league, Price was named the WNBA's Rookie of the Year in 2007.

### **SUPERMAN IN THE BUILDING**

NBA All-Star Dwight Howard of the Orlando Magic has been spotted at a number of Dream home games. The Atlanta native is a big supporter of the WNBA and frequently attended Dream games last season. Other notables spotted at Philips Arena this summer include NBA legend Julius "Dr. J" Erving, Atlanta City Council President and mayoral candidate Lisa Borders, Atlanta Hawks forwards Josh Smith and Marvin Williams, Boston Celtics guard Rajon Rondo and Atlanta Falcons defensive end John Abraham.

# Marynell Meadors

General Manager and Head Coach Marynell Meadors makes her fourth stop in the WNBA, bringing with her more than 35 years of coaching experience. Meadors enters her second season as General Manager and Head Coach of the Dream where she looks to turn around a team that finished 4-30 as an expansion team in 2008. As General Manager of the Dream, Meadors has made some notable acquisitions, including the signings of six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw and highly coveted free agent center Michelle Snow this offseason.

Prior to joining the Dream, Meadors spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the Washington Mystics. There she helped head coaches Richie Adubato and Tree Rollins to an aggregate record of 50-52, including a playoff appearance in 2006. Meadors aided the Mystics' rapid turnaround in 2007 when the squad narrowly missed the playoffs – they were eliminated on the final day of the season – after an 0-8 start.

Meadors also served as the first General Manager and Head Coach of the now-defunct Charlotte Sting where she led the franchise to the playoffs in each of its first two seasons. She also served as the Sting's director of player and staff personnel.

Following her tenure with the Sting, Meadors moved south where she was hired as the director of scouting for the Miami Sol. With the Sol, her responsibilities included advanced scouting of opponents and player evaluations for the WNBA Draft.

Meadors has an extensive background in the women's college game. For two seasons prior to joining the Mystics, she served as an assistant coach for the University of Pittsburgh, focusing her efforts on recruiting, scheduling, scouting, academics and community involvement.

Meadors was a head coach at Florida State and Tennessee Tech for a combined 30 years. At Florida State, she quickly turned the program around from three straight losing seasons prior to her arrival. The apex of her tenure came in 1991 when the Seminoles won the Metro Conference Championship and advanced to second round of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to Western Kentucky. A year earlier, she drove the Seminoles to the NCAA Tournament, though the squad was unable to advance past the opening round.

Before heading to Florida State, Meadors earned her stripes at Tennessee Tech where she won more than 300 games as head coach. She was the first head coach of the women's basketball program and in her 20 years at the helm, she posted a school-record .723 winning percentage. During her tenure, she received numerous accolades, including two Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year awards and a Metro Conference Coach of the Year award. While at Tennessee Tech, she steered her Golden Eagles squads to four OVC championships and two Metro Conference titles and became the first major women's college coach to win 350 games at one institution.
