CHASING MORE HISTORY: Already the WNBA's all-time leader in scoring and three-point field goals, **Diana Taurasi** continues to chase history in 2018, as Taurasi is 107 points shy of becoming the first player in WNBA history to score 8,000 career points ,

LEAGUE OF HER OWN:

In the Mercury's season opener against the Dallas Wings on Friday, May 18, 2018, Diana Taurasi became the first and only WNBA player in history to reach 1,000 career made three-pointers. Additionally, having done so in her 399th career game, Taurasi joined **Steph Curry, Klay Thompson** and **Damian Lillard** as the only players in WNBA/NBA history to reach 1,000 career three-pointers in 400 games or less.

MOMS IN THE DESERT: This season the Mercury feature three players on its roster who are moms, as well as two on the coaching staff. **Diana Taurasi, Sancho Lyttle** and **DeWanna Bonner** (had twins) are all recent moms, while assistant coach **Julie Hairgrove** and head coach **Sandy Brondello** have a bit more experience. As Diana put it during an interview, "it'll be like kidchella this season."

21-7-2 CLUB: In 26 games a season ago, **Brittney Griner** averaged a league-leading 21.9 points (career high), 7.6 rebounds and league-best 2.5 blocks per game, making her the only WNBA player last year to average at least 21 points, 7 rebounds and 2 blocks per game. The only NBA player to average 21-7-2 during the 2017-18 season was **Anthony Davis**, while the only NBA players to average at least 21 points and 7 rebounds per game in 2017-18 were Davis, **Russel Westbrook, LeBron James, Karl-Anthony Towns, Demarcus Cousins, Giannis Antetokounmpo, Blake Griffin** and **LaMarcus Aldridge, Joel Embid**

AIN'T NOTHIN BUT A "BG" THANG: Mercury center **Brittney Griner** continues to prove that she may just be the greatest rim protector in league history, as she ranks 8th on the WNBA's all-time blocks list with 489 blocks in only 148 career games (ranks second among active players behind Sylvia Fowles - 532 blocks in 272 career games)...After leading the league in total blocks during the 2016 season for a fourth-straight year with 107, she recorded her third consecutive year with 100+ blocks in a season, becoming just the second WNBA player (Margo Dydek) to do so... Griner finished second in total blocks in 2017 with 65, but missed 8 games due to injury (Sylvia Fowles and Elizabeth Williams each finished with 67 blocks last season and appeared in all 34 games)...Griner averaged 3.1 blocks per game in 2016, making her the first WNBA player in history to average 3.0+ blocks per game in each of her first four seasons... The last player in the NBA to average 3.0 blocks per game in each of his first four seasons in the NBA was Shawn Bradley (1993-94 to 1996-97)...She also became the 11th player in WNBA history to record 400 career blocks on 9/2 at Connecticut...She did so in 115 career games, making her the fastest player in WNBA history to reach 400 career blocks. Manute Bol, David Robinson and Mark Eaton are the only NBA players to have ever recorded 400 career blocks in 115 games or less...Griner led the league during the 2017 season with 2.5 bpg... she has led the league in blocks per game in all five of her WNBA seasons

WNBA JAM: Mercury center **Brittney Griner** has recorded 10 regular-season dunks over her 138-game career....dunked in 138th career game on July 12, 2017 vs. Atlanta, 133rd career game on June 23, 2017 at Seattle, 115th career game on September 2, 2016 at Connecticut, 86th career game on September 11, 2015 vs. Los Angeles, 82nd career game on August 28, 2015 at Washington, 64th career game on July 5, 2015 at Los Angeles, 47th career game on July 15, 2014 vs. Washington, her 43rd career game on July 6, 2014 at Los Angeles and twice in her May 27, 2013 WNBA debut vs. Chicago making her the first player in WNBA history to dunk twice in one game.....the rest of the WNBA combined enters the 2017 season with a total of six dunks (Elias Sports Bureau).....Griner also dunked in Game 2 of the Western Conference Finals at Los Angeles on August 24, 2014, at the WNBA All-Star Game on July 19, 2014 in Phoenix and at the WNBA All-Star Game on July 25, 2015 in Connecticut

THE X-FACTOR MARKS THE SPOT: The Phoenix Mercury boast the second-best home record in the WNBA since the 2014 season. Phoenix finished 9-8 in home games last season, 11-6 in 2016, tied with Minnesota for the best home record in the WNBA in 2015 at 13-4 (.765) and went 17-1 (.944) at home in 2014.

A SQUAD WITH EXPERIENCE: With offseason additions **Briann January** and **Sancho Lyttle**, the Mercury feature a roster with much postseason experience and success. The 11-player roster features the following combined numbers:

COACHING STAFF: Mercury head coach **Sandy Brondello** returns for her fifth year with the Mercury....Brondello was signed to a multi-year contract following last season on October 13, 2016.... Brondello is assisted by **Julie Hairgrove** (13th season) and **Todd Troxel** (4th season)....Brondello has a career record of 98-73 as head coach in the WNBA and a 84-53 record with the Mercury as head coach, **which is the most wins in WNBA history by a head coach in their first four years with a team.** She holds the best win percentage (.613) among all Mercury coaches in franchise history who have coached for at least one full season (Russ Pennell coached for 13 games and had a .692 win percentage), and is tied for the most playoff wins by a coach in Mercury history with 11.

BACK IN THE DESERT: Returning to the desert this

summer is **Briann January**, who the Mercury acquired from Indiana in a trade that sent the 8th overall pick in the 2018 WNBA Draft to the Fever. While this will be January's first season with the Mercury, it won't be her first rodeo in Phoenix, as the former WNBA Champion player her college basketball just up the road at Arizona State University. January recently served as an assistant coach on the women's basketball staff during the 2017-18 season.

NEW TO THE MIGHTY MERCURY: Building off a roster that reached the WNBA Semifinals a season ago, the Mercury added new players to its already talented roster for 2018. In addition to the Mercury's draft picks and training camp signees, new to this year's team is **Sancho Lyttle** (free agent), **Briann January** (acquired from Indiana in a trade), and **DeWanna Bonner** (missed 2017 season due to pregnancy)

TROPHY CASE: The Mercury won their third WNBA Championship in 2014 and became the third franchise in the then 19-year history of the league with three or more championships.....the Houston Comets (1997, 1998, 1999, 2000) and Detroit Shock (now Dallas, previously Tulsa) (2003, 2006, 2008) are the other two. Minnesota joined the list in 2015, while Los Angeles joined in 2016.

FIFTH SEASON AS HEAD COACH OF PHOENIX •



Veteran WNBA player, coach and former Australian Olympian Sandy Brondello (braun-DELL-oh) was named the ninth head coach in franchise history on November 15, 2013. Brondello also serves as the team's vice president of player personnel. On October 13, 2016, the Mercury signed Brondello to a multi-year contract extension.

Known for her intense preparation for each opponent, Brondello has compiled an overall regular season record of 84-53 in her first four seasons with the Mercury, ranking her second on the all-time wins list as a Mercury coach. Additionally, Brondello has compiled a 13-9 postseason record at the helm of the Mercury, ranking her as the winningest coach in franchise history in the postseason. She was named the 2014 WNBA Coach of the Year marking the first time a Mercury coach picked up the honor. She led the team to a WNBA regular season-record 29 wins and capped the season with a WNBA Championship.

An 13-year veteran of the WNBA coaching ranks, Brondello has been affiliated with the league for 19 of the league's 22 seasons, including her time as a player. A proven winner internationally and in the WNBA, her 13 total years as an assistant coach and head coach have featured 10 playoff appearances, including seven semifinals round berths (formerly conference finals), the 2014 WNBA Championship and a spot in the 2008 WNBA Finals. Brondello joins the Mercury after serving as lead assistant coach for the Los Angeles Sparks (2011-13) under 2012 WNBA Coach of the Year Carol Ross. Brondello led the San Antonio Silver Stars to a 2010 playoff berth in her lone season at the helm following five seasons on the Silver Stars bench as an assistant under Dan Hughes (2005-09), the third-winningest coach in league history.

A 2010 inductee into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame, Brondello was named the 11th head coach for the Australian Women's National Basketball team on April 17, 2017. While she continues to serve in her role as head coach for the Mercury, Brondello will spend her off seasons preparing the Aussies for a trip to the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo. Most recently, Brondello led the Australian National Team to the gold medal in the 2018 Commonwealth Games, finishing with a perfect 5-0 in the games and winning by an average of 53 points per game.

During the WNBA offseason, Brondello used to serve as an assistant coach with Russian League team UMMC Ekaterinburg. Now the Mercury's head of player personnel, Phoenix's pro scouting efforts are buoyed by Brondello's knowledge of and exposure to overseas talent.

Brondello finished a stellar 17-year professional playing career with a five-year run in the WNBA in which she played for Detroit (1998-99), Miami (2001-02) and Seattle (2003), and was named a 1999 WNBA All-Star. She began her career with the Women's National Basketball League (WNBL) in Australia (1986-96), and was named the league MVP in 1995. The 5-7 guard was a 10-time German Cup champion while playing with BTV Wuppertal (1992-2002), a three-time European Cup All-Star selection (1994, 1996, 1997), and the 1996 European Cup MVP when she led her team to the title.

An 18-year member of the Australian National Team, Brondello is a four-time Olympian, a two-time silver medalist (2000, 2004) and was named the 1992 Australian International Player of the Year. In her time with the national team, she was a teammate of former Mercury forward, and current Director of Player Performance for Phoenix, Penny Taylor.

Brondello is married to Olaf Lange, who is the head coach of UMMC Ekaterinburg, and the couple has two children, Brody and Jayda.
