NOTEWORTHY

STANDING TALL

Second-year forward/center Jonquel Jones followed up a career-high 20 rebounds against the Atlanta Dream on May 13th by securing her first double-double of the season with 19 points and 12 rebounds in the 81-79 loss at Indiana on Saturday night at Bankers Life Fieldhouse. Against the Dream, Jones also had career-highs for both offensive rebounds (seven) and defensive rebounds (13) while becoming just the second player in franchise history to record 20 or more rebounds in a single game. Tina Charles set the team record with 23 rebounds against both Los Angeles (6/28/11) and Phoenix (6/25/10), and had 20 or more rebounds five times with the Sun. In the 2017 WNBA GM Survey, Jones received 25 percent of the votes for player most likely to have a breakout season. She closed out her rookie season in the WNBA last year by scoring a career-high 21 points with three made threes in a win at Washington (9/18). She followed that up by helping Woori Bank win a championship in South Korea this offseason.

DREAM START FOR TUCK

Second-year forward Morgan Tuck had 13 points and six rebounds at Indiana, and she leads the Sun in scoring (17 ppg.), made threes (4 of 7) and made free throws (8 of 8). Tuck scored a career-high 21 points against the Atlanta Dream (5/13), shooting 7-for-18 from the field and 3-for-6 from behind the arc. Her 18 field goal attempts and six three-point attempts were also career-highs. As a rookie in 2016, Tuck appeared in 26 games with three starts but hurt her left knee in Atlanta on August 28th. She eventually had surgery to repair cartilage damage on September 13th.

LEARNING TO CLOSE

In each of the first two games of the regular season – losses to the Atlanta Dream on May 13th and on the road at Indiana Saturday – the score was tied at 72 in the closing minutes. Against the Dream, Connecticut was outscored 9-2 in the last 2:59 of an 81-74 loss. At Indiana, the Sun were outscored 9-7 in the last 1:39 of the game. In the loss at Indiana, the Sun led by 10 in the first minute of the fourth quarter, but were eventually outscored 29-19 in the quarter.

A FOUL STORY

Through two games, the Sun have already been outscored by a combined 26 points at the free throw line. Connecticut is 27 of 35 while Atlanta and Indiana were a combined 53 of 56. The Dream tied a WNBA record by making 21 of 21 free throws in the first half – Los Angeles was 21 of 21 in the second half of a game in 2003 – and the Fever outscored Connecticut 13-3 from the line during its fourth-quarter comeback. Opponents made 158 more free throws than Connecticut last year, an average of 4.6 points per game. That was a crucial difference considering that Connecticut was outscored by a scant 1.4 points (84.4-83) while finishing 14-20. A total of 21 Connecticut games were decided by nine points or less and 11 were decided by five points or less.

BANHAM COMES BACK

Former University of Minnesota star Rachel Banham saw her rookie season with the Connecticut Sun cut short in 2016 because of knee surgery. Banham, who will return to her home state for the second time as a professional, was dealing with pain in her right knee from the start of training camp last season, and eventually had micro-fracture surgery on July 8th. The fourth overall pick in the 2016 WNBA Draft played in 15 just games last season, and has been limited to nine minutes in two games this season.

GUARDED OPTIMISM

Second-year guard Courtney Williams, who had 10 points and five rebounds at Indiana, made her first seven shots off the bench in the home opener against the Dream last Saturday, finishing with 18 points to go along with five rebounds and an assist. She was 8-for-14 from the field and 2-for-3 from three-point range. Williams didn't miss a single shot until the third quarter and had gone 7-for-7 from the field to start the game, one shy of the franchise re-cord for most field goal attempts made without a miss (8). Her 18 points were just two points shy of her career-high, set last season with 20 points against New York (9/9/16).

SHRINKING NUMBERS

Connecticut went into the game at Indiana without starting point guard Jasmine Thomas, who missed the game to attend her brother's wedding. They were also without starting forward Alyssa Thomas, who is still in concussion protocol. It got worse for the Sun late in the game as starting center Jonquel Jones fouled out with 2:43 remaining and Danielle Adams picked up her sixth foul a minute later. That left the Sun with eight players in a game tied at 72.

NOTEWORTHY

ADAMS GETS GOING

Veteran forward Danielle Adams made her first appearance in a regular season game with the Sun at Indiana, and finished with nine points on three made threes. She hit her first three attempts from behind the arc, demonstrating the range that allowed her to appear in 155 games with San Antonio, where she played from 2011 until she was waived on April 29, 2016. Connecticut signed Adams to a training camp contract on February 22nd, and she shot her way onto the roster by making 8 of 12 threes in the preseason, including 5 of 5 in the first half of a win over the Los Angeles Sparks on May 3rd. She was 12-of-20 from the field overall in three preseason games, averaging 11.3 points off the Adams played in Israel this off-season, helping Maccabi Ramat Gan reach the league final.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY

Saturday's game against the Fever was the first time Lynetta Kizer returned to Indiana since being traded to Connecticut on February 21st. Kizer, who had 12 points on 5-of-8 shooting, spent three seasons with Indiana (2014-16) before joining the Sun. She appeared in 97 games with 27 starts.

GETTING BETTER ALL THE TIME

Veteran point guard Jasmine Thomas, who the Sun acquired in a 2015 WNBA Draft Day trade with Atlanta for rookie Brittaney Hrynko, continues to evolve into one of the top point guards in the WNBA. For the second straight year, she established new single-season career highs for assists (172), points (11.7), rebounds (140) and steals (43). She is off to a good start this season with a double-digit scoring effort (14 points) to go along with two rebounds and three assists against Atlanta (5/13). Thomas has played in every WNBA game (205 straight) since she was drafted out of Duke by the Seattle Storm with the 12th pick in 2011. In addition, last week's game marked her 150th career start.

JUST WARMING UP

The Sun were among the hottest teams in the WNBA during the second half of the 2016 season, finishing 11-7 with a three-game winning streak to close out 2016. That stretch included two wins over defending champion Minnesota, two wins over playoff-bound Indiana and victories over playoff participants Chicago and Phoenix. Connecticut was involved in 21 games decided by nine points or less, with an 8-3 record in games decided by five points or less.

BALANCING THE SCOREBOOK

Throughout her WNBA career, forward Alyssa Thomas has shown the ability to contribute in a number of different ways for the Sun. In limited preseason minutes this year, Thomas had seven steals, 10 rebounds, and collected 21 points on 10 of 20 shooting. Last weekend against Atlanta, she posted seven points, five rebounds and three assists before leaving the game early because of concussion-like symptoms. Last year, she led the Sun in steals (44), was second in rebounds (187), third in assists (70) and fourth in scoring (11.1 ppg). In her second season in South Korea, Thomas averaged 15.3 points, 10.3 rebounds and 2.8 assists through 28 games for Samsung Life. Her team reached the WKBL Finals, but Jonquel Jones and Woori Bank swept to the title. Thomas averaged 11.3 points, 11.7 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game in the championship series against Woori Bank, including a 21 point, 16 rebound double-double effort in Game 1 of the finals.

BENTLEY IS BACK

Veteran guard Alex Bentley, who missed all of preseason with a minor ankle injury, had 14 points three assists and two steals in the loss at Indiana. Bentley averaged a team-high 12.9 points per game last year, scoring her 1,500th career point in the last game of last year, at Washington (9/18).

TERRAPIN STATION

With the trade for Lynetta Kizer and the selection of Brionna Jones with the eighth overall pick in the 2017 WNBA Draft, the Sun now have three Maryland players on the roster. Alyssa Thomas, the third Terrapin on the team, actually played with both Kizer and Jones.
