TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

The Dream start off a five-game road swing with a trip to the Big Apple, where they will take on the New York Liberty on Saturday evening. This is the second matchup between the two teams with New York leading the season series 1-0. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:30 pm ET at Madison Square Garden. The game will also be webcast live on www.AtlantaDream.net.

The Dream (6-7) are looking to gain ground in the Eastern Conference after defeating Connecticut at home on Tuesday 72-67. Chamique Holdsclaw led the way for the Dream scoring 19 points and collecting seven rebounds. Erika de Souza recorded her third double-double of the year with 12 points and 17 boards (tied season-high). Four out of the five Dream starters were in double figures in Tuesday's victory over the Sun.

The Liberty (3-6) have lost four of their last five games, including a 69-60 loss to the Los Angeles Sparks on Thursday. Janel McCarville led the way for New York with 18 points and six rebounds. Essence Carson added 12. New York is led by forward Shameka Christon who is averaging just over 18 points per game. McCarville is the only other player on the Liberty roster to average double figures so far this season. McCarville is averaging ten points and five rebounds per game.

The Liberty won the previous matchup this season in Atlanta. Christon scored 17 and McCarville added 15 as New York would go on to defeat the Dream 93-81 on June 21. The Liberty had one of their more productive offensive games of the season, shooting 57.4% from the field and going 9-18 from the three point line. New York would record a season high 26 assists in the June 21 matchup at Atlanta.

The Dream are looking for their first victory in franchise history against New York. The Dream are 0-4 all time against the Liberty, losing all three matchups last season.

NEXT OPPONENT

The Dream continue their longest road swing of the season on Wednesday, July 15 against the Minnesota Lynx. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 pm ET at the Target Center. Minnesota leads the season series 1-0, winning the first matchup 91-85 on June 30 in Atlanta.

NEWS AND NOTES

LIFE ON THE ROAD

The Dream are set to embark on their longest road trip of the season, a five-game swing that begins July 11 against New York and wraps up on July 22 against the Detroit Shock. Atlanta currently sits just one game under .500 in a tightly contested Eastern Conference race that currently features three teams at the .500 mark (includes games through July 9). The Dream have struggled on the road so far this season with an overall record of 1-4 away from home.

FIRST HALF SETS THE TONE

The Dream's 19-point halftime lead over the Connecticut Sun on July 7 was a franchise record. Atlanta fended off a strong second-half comeback by the Sun to hang on for a 72-67 victory. The Dream are now 5-0 in games where they are leading at the half.

LATTA'S BACK

The Dream waived starting point guard Nikki Teasley on July 3 and signed guard Ivory Latta. Teasley started all ten games this season for the Dream, averaging 3.9 points, 1.7 rebounds and 3.5 assists in 23.4 minutes per game. Latta was waived by the Dream exactly one month ago on June 3 prior to the start of the regular season. She started 31 of 34 games for the Dream last season, averaging 11.4 points, 2.1 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game. Coco Miller and Shalee Lehning have shared time at the point guard, with Miller starting the last three games for the Dream.

DREAM SETS FRANCHISE RECORD FOR WINS

With a victory over the Washington Mystics on July 3, the Dream surpassed their total wins from a season ago, moving to 5-6 on the year. The Dream started last season 0-17 before finishing with a 4-30 record. They did not record their fourth win of the season until September 11.

DOUBLE DIGIT SCORERS

The Dream's three leading scorers (Lyttle, Holdsclaw, de Souza) have been consistent in their offensive production this season. Lyttle has scored in double figures in 12 of 13 games this season, including five 15+ point games. Holdsclaw has scored in double figures in 11 of 13 games. De Souza has scored in double figures in nine of 13 games.

THREE POINT WOES

While the Dream has been dominant inside this season, the team continues to have early season struggles from beyond the arc. Atlanta is currently giving up 38.3% to opponents from three-point range, which is the second highest percentage in the league. On the offensive end, the Dream are connecting on only 28.8% from three, which ranks 12th out of 13 teams in the league.

A BALANCED ATTACK

Currently nine of eleven Dream players are averaging double digits in minutes played, all averaging over 13 minutes per game. Five different Dream players have led the team in scoring this season. Rookie Angel McCoughtry has been the Dream's most efficient player off the bench, averaging 9.5 points, 2.1 rebounds, and 1.8 assists per game. Rookie Shalee Lehning saw her most extensive action of the season against Connecticut on July 7. Lehning dished out a career-high seven assists in 29 minutes. Her 2.7 assists per game currently leads the team.

DREAM DUO DOMINATES THE PAINT

The Atlanta Dream have outscored their opponents under the basket in ten out of the first 13 games of the season. This surge of inside scoring can be attributed to the duo of Sancho Lyttle (13.8 ppg, 6.5 rpg) and Erika de Souza (11.2 ppg, 8.4 rpg). Lyttle has two double-doubles this season and de Souza recorded her third double-double on Tuesday. The duo also leads the league in field goal percentage, De Souza ranks tenth with 56% and Lyttle ranks 11th with 55.9%. Lyttle or de Souza has led the team in rebounding in 11 of 13 games this season.

SUPERMAN IN THE BUILDING

NBA All-Star Dwight Howard of the Orlando Magic has been spotted at a number of Dream home games. The Atlanta native is a big supporter of the WNBA and frequently attended Dream games last season. Other notables spotted at Philips Arena this summer include NBA legend Julius "Dr. J" Erving, Atlanta City Council President Lisa Borders and Atlanta Hawks forward Josh Smith.

MILESTONES FOR MIQUE

It took only 2 minutes and 37 seconds in Chamique Holdsclaw's return to the WNBA on June 6 for the forward to reach another milestone in her WNBA career. Holdsclaw's steal at the 7:23 minute mark in the first quarter against the Fever put her over the 300 mark for her career. After scoring 23 points during season opener, Holdsclaw was two points shy of 4,000. It would take only 1:46 into the first quarter for her to reach that milestone as she would make both free throws after being fouled by Monique Currie. Holdsclaw is only the ninth player in WNBA history to score more than 4,000 career points.

DREAM GETS A MAKEOVER

After finishing last season with a league worst 4-30 record, the Atlanta Dream overhauled the roster. With the return of Ivory Latta, the Dream's roster now features five players returning from last year's expansion team (Izi Castro Marques, Erika de Souza, Ivory Latta, Tamera Young, Jennifer Lacy). De Souza missed 22 games last season due to a fractured leg.

General Manager and Head Coach Marynell Meadors makes her fourth stop in the WNBA, bringing with her more than 35 years of coaching experience. Meadors enters her second season as General Manager and Head Coach of the Dream where she looks to turn around a team that finished 4-30 as an expansion team in 2008. As General Manager of the Dream, Meadors has made some notable acquisitions, including the signings of six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw and highly coveted free agent center Michelle Snow this offseason.

Prior to joining the Dream, Meadors spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the Washington Mystics. There she helped head coaches Richie Adubato and Tree Rollins to an aggregate record of 50-52, including a playoff appearance in 2006. Meadors aided the Mystics' rapid turnaround in 2007 when the squad narrowly missed the playoffs – they were eliminated on the final day of the season – after an 0-8 start.

Meadors also served as the first General Manager and Head Coach of the now-defunct Charlotte Sting where she led the franchise to the playoffs in each of its first two seasons. She also served as the Sting's director of player and staff personnel.

Following her tenure with the Sting, Meadors moved south where she was hired as the director of scouting for the Miami Sol. With the Sol, her responsibilities included advanced scouting of opponents and player evaluations for the WNBA Draft.

Meadors has an extensive background in the women's college game. For two seasons prior to joining the Mystics, she served as an assistant coach for the University of Pittsburgh, focusing her efforts on recruiting, scheduling, scouting, academics and community involvement.

Meadors was a head coach at Florida State and Tennessee Tech for a combined 30 years. At Florida State, she quickly turned the program around from three straight losing seasons prior to her arrival. The apex of her tenure came in 1991 when the Seminoles won the Metro Conference Championship and advanced to second round of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to Western Kentucky. A year earlier, she drove the Seminoles to the NCAA Tournament, though the squad was unable to advance past the opening round.

Before heading to Florida State, Meadors earned her stripes at Tennessee Tech where she won more than 300 games as head coach. She was the first head coach of the women's basketball program and in her 20 years at the helm, she posted a school-record .723 winning percentage. During her tenure, she received numerous accolades, including two Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year awards and a Metro Conference Coach of the Year award. While at Tennessee Tech, she steered her Golden Eagles squads to four OVC championships and two Metro Conference titles and became the first major women's college coach to win 350 games at one institution

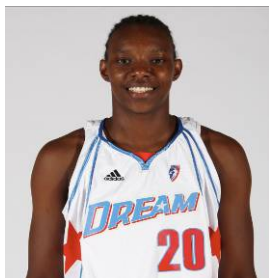
