TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

The Dream head into the All-Star break with a matchup against the Detroit Shock, ending their five game road swing. Atlanta is 1-0 this season against Detroit. Tip-off is scheduled for noon ET as the Shock celebrate Kids Day. The game will be webcast live at www.AtlantaDream.net.

The Dream (7-10) are still searching for answers on the road, where they are 2-7 this season. After an impressive 91-77 road victory over Minnesota Lynx last Wednesday, the Dream dropped back-to-back games over the weekend to the Indiana Fever and New York Liberty. The Dream came back from a 20 point deficit in the second half, but let it slip away, 89-86 against New York. Erika de Souza led the way for the Dream, recording her fifth double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds. Chamique Holdsclaw finished with 26 points and Izi Castro Marques added 24 in the losing effort. New York went 11-27 from three to remain undefeated against the Dream in franchise history.

After a slow start, the defending champion Shock (5-8) have won three of their last four, as they look to get back on track and make a run at the playoffs. Detroit traveled to Sacramento on Sunday, defeating the Monarchs 69-65. Veteran forward Taj McWilliams led the way for the Shock with 21 points and 12 rebounds. Rookie Shante Zellous added 11 points off the bench, and Deanna Nolan (11) finished in double figures as well.

The Dream are 1-0 this season against the Shock, winning 93-81 at home on June 26. Tonight's matchup features two former University of Georgia teammates, Atlanta's Coco Miller and Detroit's Nolan. Detroit guard Kristin Haynie will make her second appearance against her former team. Haynie averaged 2.8 points and 2.5 assists in 14.7 minutes per game last season for the Dream.

After Wednesday's game, the Dream have a full week off heading into the All-Star break. Erika de Souza and Sancho Lyttle earned their first All-Star selections, getting voted in as reserves by the Eastern Conference coaches.

NEXT OPPONENT

The Dream return to action on July 30 at home against the Phoenix Mercury. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. ET at Philips Arena. Phoenix currently sits in first place in the Western conference.

NEWS AND NOTES

LIFE ON THE ROAD

The Dream are in the midst of their longest road trip of the season, a five-game swing that began July 11 against New York and wraps up with today's matchup against the Detroit Shock. Atlanta currently sits three games under .500 in a tightly contested Eastern Conference race. The Dream have struggled on the road so far this season with an overall record of 2-7 away from home.

DREAM FRONTCOURT DUO EARNS ALL-STAR NOD

Dream frontcourt partners Erika de Souza and Sancho Lyttle were selected for the 2009 WNBA All-Star game this week, the first appearance for both. De Souza and Lyttle were voted in as reserves by the Eastern Conference coaches and will be the first All-Star selections in franchise history (there was no All-Star game in 2008 due to the Olympics). The 2009 WNBA All-Star Game will tip-off at Mohegan Sun at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 25 and will be nationally televised on ABC.

FIRST HALF FORTUNE

The Dream's first-half performance has been a key indicator of the end result this season. Atlanta is 6-1 in games that they lead at the half. The Dream's 19-point halftime lead over the Connecticut Sun on July 7 was a franchise record.

ALMOST DOESN'T COUNT

Of the Dream's 10 losses this season, only two have been double digit losses. In Atlanta's last five games, the largest margin of defeat has been six points. Five of the Dream's losses this season have been by a margin of five points or less.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

The Dream's 91 points against Minnesota on July 15 marked the fourth time Atlanta has scored over 90 points this season. The Dream are 3-1 in games in which they top the 90 point mark. Atlanta currently averages 80.1 points per game which ranks third in the league.

DREAM DOMINATING THE PAINT

The Atlanta Dream have outscored their opponents under the basket in 15 out of the first 17 games of the season. This surge of inside scoring can be attributed to the duo of Sancho Lyttle (13.5 ppg, 6.7 rpg) and Erika de Souza (11.5 ppg, 8.6 rpg). Lyttle has two double-doubles this season and de Souza has five, including a 23 point, 14 rebound performance on Friday. The duo also ranks among league leaders in field goal percentage. De Souza ranks second with 57.7% and Lyttle ranks eighth with 51.4%. Lyttle or de Souza has led the team in rebounding in 14 of 17 games this season.

DOUBLE DIGIT SCORERS

The Dream trio of Sancho Lyttle, Chamique Holdsclaw and Erika de Souza have been consistent in their offensive production this season. Lyttle has scored in double figures in 14 of 17 games this season, including seven 15+ point games. Holdsclaw has scored in double figures in 14 of 17 games, topping the 15+ mark seven times. De Souza has scored in double figures in 12 of 17 games.

BEYOND THE ARC

The Dream shot a season-high 77.8% (7-9) from three against Minnesota on July 15, outscoring their opponent from beyond the arc for the first time this season. The Dream's perimeter struggles returned two days later in a loss to the Indiana Fever on July 15, during which the Dream went 2-7 from three while giving up nine three-pointers (9-16) to Indiana. In a loss to New York on Sunday, the Dream gave up eleven three pointers while connecting only on two. The Dream currently ranks 12th out of 13 teams in three-point field goal percentage (29.5%) while opponents shoot 37.8% against the Dream.

A BALANCED ATTACK

Currently ten of eleven Dream players are averaging double digits in minutes played, with six averaging over 15 minutes per game. Four of the Dream's five starters are averaging double figures for the season. Rookie Angel McCoughtry has been the Dream's most efficient player off the bench, averaging 8.8 points, 2.1 rebounds, and 1.5 assists per game.

DREAM SETS FRANCHISE RECORD FOR WINS

With a victory over the Washington Mystics on July 3, the Dream surpassed their total wins from a season ago. The Dream started last season 0-17 before finishing with a 4-30 record. They did not record their fourth win of the season until September 11.

SUPERMAN IN THE BUILDING

NBA All-Star Dwight Howard of the Orlando Magic has been spotted at a number of Dream home games. The Atlanta native is a big supporter of the WNBA and frequently attended Dream games last season. Other notables spotted at Philips Arena this summer include NBA legend Julius "Dr. J" Erving, Atlanta City Council President Lisa Borders, Atlanta Hawks forward Josh Smith and Atlanta Falcons defensive end John Abraham.

DREAM GETS A MAKEOVER

After finishing last season with a league worst 4-30 record, the Atlanta Dream overhauled the roster. With the return of Ivory Latta, the Dream's roster now features five players returning from last year's expansion team (Izi Castro Marques, Erika de Souza, Ivory Latta, Tamera Young, Jennifer Lacy). De Souza missed 22 games last season due to a fractured leg.

General Manager and Head Coach Marynell Meadors makes her fourth stop in the WNBA, bringing with her more than 35 years of coaching experience. Meadors enters her second season as General Manager and Head Coach of the Dream where she looks to turn around a team that finished 4-30 as an expansion team in 2008. As General Manager of the Dream, Meadors has made some notable acquisitions, including the signings of six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw and highly coveted free agent center Michelle Snow this offseason.

Prior to joining the Dream, Meadors spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the Washington Mystics. There she helped head coaches Richie Adubato and Tree Rollins to an aggregate record of 50-52, including a playoff appearance in 2006. Meadors aided the Mystics' rapid turnaround in 2007 when the squad narrowly missed the playoffs – they were eliminated on the final day of the season – after an 0-8 start.

Meadors also served as the first General Manager and Head Coach of the now-defunct Charlotte Sting where she led the franchise to the playoffs in each of its first two seasons. She also served as the Sting's director of player and staff personnel.

Following her tenure with the Sting, Meadors moved south where she was hired as the director of scouting for the Miami Sol. With the Sol, her responsibilities included advanced scouting of opponents and player evaluations for the WNBA Draft.

Meadors has an extensive background in the women's college game. For two seasons prior to joining the Mystics, she served as an assistant coach for the University of Pittsburgh, focusing her efforts on recruiting, scheduling, scouting, academics and community involvement.

Meadors was a head coach at Florida State and Tennessee Tech for a combined 30 years. At Florida State, she quickly turned the program around from three straight losing seasons prior to her arrival. The apex of her tenure came in 1991 when the Seminoles won the Metro Conference Championship and advanced to second round of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to Western Kentucky. A year earlier, she drove the Seminoles to the NCAA Tournament, though the squad was unable to advance past the opening round.

Before heading to Florida State, Meadors earned her stripes at Tennessee Tech where she won more than 300 games as head coach. She was the first head coach of the women's basketball program and in her 20 years at the helm, she posted a school-record .723 winning percentage. During her tenure, she received numerous accolades, including two Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year awards and a Metro Conference Coach of the Year award. While at Tennessee Tech, she steered her Golden Eagles squads to four OVC championships and two Metro Conference titles and became the first major women's college coach to win 350 games at one institution
