TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

The Dream head home for the first time since July 7, as they take on the Western-Conference leading Phoenix Mercury. The Dream are 0-2 against the Mercury all-time. This is the first matchup this season between the two teams. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:30 PM EST Thursday night at Phillips Arena as the Dream celebrate "Go Green" night. The game will be webcast live at www.AtlantaDream.net.

The Dream (8-10) are looking to make a push in the tightly contested playoff race as the second half of the season gets underway. Atlanta is coming off a week's rest as their last matchup before the All-Star break was on July 22 against Detroit. In that game, the Dream upended the defending champs 98-95 in overtime. The Dream bench came up big, scoring 58 of the team's 98 points. Ivory Latta (22 pts), Michelle Snow (16 pts), and Angel McCoughtry (20 pts) were each in double figures off the bench. Latta was perfect from the field (5-5 including 2-2 from three) and from the free throw line (10-10).

The Mercury (14-5) are currently in first place in the Western Conference behind a high-powered offense featuring the WNBA's two leading scorers (Diana Taurasi- 21.3 ppg and Cappie Pondexter- 20.6 ppg). Phoenix has won eight of its last nine games and is 6-0 against Eastern Conference opponents this season. Taurasi has returned to the starting lineup following a two-game suspension before the All-Star break and Pondexter has been on a tear, earning three consecutive Player of the Week awards prior to the All-Star break. The Mercury won their most recent matchup 95-80 over the Connecticut Sun behind Pondexter's season-high 29 points. Taurasi added 17 points and nine rebounds in the victory.

Atlanta guard Iziane Castro Marques and forward Jennifer Lacy will match up against their former team tonight. Castro Marques played for the Mercury in 2003, her second season in the league, averaging 4.3 points per game. In 2006, Lacy won the WNBA Championship with the Mercury averaging five points per game.

NEXT OPPONENT

The Dream will play host to the New York Liberty on Saturday, August 1. The Dream are 0-6 all time vs. the Liberty, losing all three of this season's matchups. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:00 PM EST at Philips Arena.

NEWS AND NOTES

FRANCHISE'S FIRST ALL-STARS

Dream frontcourt partners Erika de Souza and Sancho Lyttle represented the Dream in the 2009 WNBA All-Star game last week, the first All-Star appearance for both players. De Souza and Lyttle were voted in as reserves by the Eastern Conference coaches and are the first All-Star selections in franchise history (there was no All-Star game in 2008 due to the Olympics). De Souza scored 12 points and collected nine rebounds, and Lyttle scored six points with eight rebounds, but the West was victorious, 130-118.

DREAM GOES GREEN

The Dream will celebrate "Go Green" night today at the arena. The first 3,000 fans will receive a water bottle courtesy of MARTA. Fans that show their MARTA Breeze card at the Philips Arena box office will receive a 10% discount. Fans can also capture their memories with a photo at the MARTA "Green Screen" located on the concourse. During warm-ups, players will wear "Go Green" shooting shirts made of 100% organic cotton. The Dream recently teamed up with Trees Atlanta for a "Go Green" project at Isabel Gates Webster Park. Shalee Lehning, Coco Miller and Sancho Lyttle participated alongside girls from the Dream's "Power of Girls" mentoring program, mulching trees and learning about ways to reduce our environmental footprint.

SHOOTING FOR PERFECTION

Playing against her former team, guard Ivory Latta shot 100% from the field in last week's 98-95 overtime victory over the Detroit Shock. Latta went 5-5 from the field, including 2-2 from three, and converted all ten of her free throw attempts en route to a season-high 22 points.

BENCH HEROICS

The Dream bench provided Coach Marynell Meadors a boost in last week's 98-95 overtime victory over the Detroit Shock. The bench scored 58 of the team's total 98 points (59.2%). Ivory Latta led the way with 22 points and three assists. Angel McCoughtry scored 20 and Michelle Snow recorded her first double-double of the season with a season-high 16 points and 12 rebounds.

FIRST HALF FORTUNE

The Dream's first-half performance has been a key indicator of the end result this season. Atlanta is 7-1 in games that they lead at the half. The Dream's 19-point halftime lead over the Connecticut Sun on July 7 was a franchise record.

ALMOST DOESN'T COUNT

Of the Dream's 10 losses this season, only two have been double digit losses. In Atlanta's last five games, the largest margin of defeat has been six points. Five of the Dream's losses this season have been by a margin of five points or less.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

The Dream's 98 points against Detroit on July 22 marked the fifth time Atlanta has scored over 90 points this season. The Dream are 4-1 in games in which they top the 90 point mark. Atlanta currently averages 81.1 points per game which ranks third in the league.

DREAM DOMINATING THE PAINT

The Atlanta Dream have outscored their opponents under the basket in 15 out of the first 17 games of the season. This surge of inside scoring can be attributed to the duo of Sancho Lyttle (13.5 ppg, 6.7 rpg) and Erika de Souza (11.1 ppg, 8.6 rpg). Lyttle has two double-doubles this season and de Souza has five, including a 23 point, 14 rebound performance on Friday. The duo also ranks among league leaders in field goal percentage. De Souza ranks ninth with 56.5% and Lyttle ranks 18th with 51.3%. Lyttle or de Souza has led the team in rebounding in 14 of 18 games this season.

DOUBLE DIGIT SCORERS

Chamique Holdsclaw and Sancho Lyttle continue to be consistent in their offensive output for the Dream. Both Lyttle and Holdsclaw have scored in double figures in 15 of 18 games this season and both players have topped the 15+ mark seven times.

BEYOND THE ARC

The Dream have struggled to find the stroke from beyond the arc this season, as the three-point differential continues to be an indicator of the game's outcome. The Dream currently ranks last (13th) in three-point field goal percentage (29.6%) while opponents shoot 37.5% against the Dream.

DREAM DOUBLES WIN TOTAL FROM LAST SEASON

With a victory over the Detroit Shock on July 22, the Dream reached the eight-win mark, doubling their season win mark from last year. The Dream surpassed their total wins from a season ago against Washington on July 3. The Dream started last season 0-17 before finishing with a 4-30 record. They did not record their fourth win of the season until September 11.

SUPERMAN IN THE BUILDING

NBA All-Star Dwight Howard of the Orlando Magic has been spotted at a number of Dream home games. The Atlanta native is a big supporter of the WNBA and frequently attended Dream games last season. Other notables spotted at Philips Arena this summer include NBA legend Julius "Dr. J" Erving, Atlanta City Council President Lisa Borders, Atlanta Hawks forward Josh Smith and Atlanta Falcons defensive end John Abraham.

General Manager and Head Coach Marynell Meadors makes her fourth stop in the WNBA, bringing with her more than 35 years of coaching experience. Meadors enters her second season as General Manager and Head Coach of the Dream where she looks to turn around a team that finished 4-30 as an expansion team in 2008. As General Manager of the Dream, Meadors has made some notable acquisitions, including the signings of six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw and highly coveted free agent center Michelle Snow this offseason.

Prior to joining the Dream, Meadors spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the Washington Mystics. There she helped head coaches Richie Adubato and Tree Rollins to an aggregate record of 50-52, including a playoff appearance in 2006. Meadors aided the Mystics' rapid turnaround in 2007 when the squad narrowly missed the playoffs – they were eliminated on the final day of the season – after an 0-8 start.

Meadors also served as the first General Manager and Head Coach of the now-defunct Charlotte Sting where she led the franchise to the playoffs in each of its first two seasons. She also served as the Sting's director of player and staff personnel.

Following her tenure with the Sting, Meadors moved south where she was hired as the director of scouting for the Miami Sol. With the Sol, her responsibilities included advanced scouting of opponents and player evaluations for the WNBA Draft.

Meadors has an extensive background in the women's college game. For two seasons prior to joining the Mystics, she served as an assistant coach for the University of Pittsburgh, focusing her efforts on recruiting, scheduling, scouting, academics and community involvement.

Meadors was a head coach at Florida State and Tennessee Tech for a combined 30 years. At Florida State, she quickly turned the program around from three straight losing seasons prior to her arrival. The apex of her tenure came in 1991 when the Seminoles won the Metro Conference Championship and advanced to second round of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to Western Kentucky. A year earlier, she drove the Seminoles to the NCAA Tournament, though the squad was unable to advance past the opening round.

Before heading to Florida State, Meadors earned her stripes at Tennessee Tech where she won more than 300 games as head coach. She was the first head coach of the women's basketball program and in her 20 years at the helm, she posted a school-record .723 winning percentage. During her tenure, she received numerous accolades, including two Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year awards and a Metro Conference Coach of the Year award. While at Tennessee Tech, she steered her Golden Eagles squads to four OVC championships and two Metro Conference titles and became the first major women's college coach to win 350 games at one institution
