TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

The Dream travel to Indiana for a Sunday night matchup with the Indiana Fever. Atlanta is looking to halt the Fever's seven-game winning streak. Tip-off is scheduled for 6 pm ET at Conseco Field House. The game will be webcast live on www.AtlantaDream.net.

The Dream (5-6) are coming off a 72-65 victory over the Washington Mystics on Friday night. Chamique Holdsclaw led Atlanta with a game-high 18 points and a career-high eight assists. The Dream announced on Friday that the team signed guard Ivory Latta and waived Nikki Teasley. Teasley had started all ten games at point for the Dream. Coco Miller got her second start of the season on Friday and her first at the point guard spot. Latta was active but had not practiced with the team and played only one minute on Friday night.

The Fever (7-2) are sitting on top of the Eastern Conference standings and have won a franchise-record seven consecutive games behind the play of Katie Douglas (17.7 ppg, 3.2 rpg, 2.6 apg) and Tamika Catchings (14.1 ppg, 6.4 rpg, 3.8 apg). Indiana is coming off a 67-53 victory over the Connecticut Sun on July 2. Four of the five Fever starters scored in double figures, led by Tammy Sutton-Brown with 14 points and 14 rebounds. Tamika Catchings added 10 points, six rebounds and five assists for Indiana in the win.

The Dream leads the season series 1-0, defeating the Fever 87-86 on Opening Night (June 6) in double overtime at home. Chamique Holdsclaw led the way for the Dream with 23 points, seven rebounds and four assists. Erika de Souza recorded a double-double with 16 points and 17 rebounds. Katie Douglas finished with 22 points and Tamika Catchings added 15 points and nine rebounds for Indiana.

NEXT OPPONENT

The Dream return home for a Tuesday night matchup against the Connecticut Sun. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:30 pm on July 7 at Philips Arena. This is the third matchup between the two teams. The series is tied 1-1 with the Sun winning the last game 82-68 in Connecticut on June 27.

NEWS AND NOTES

LATTA'S BACK

The Dream waived starting point guard Nikki Teasley on July 3 and signed guard Ivory Latta. Teasley started all ten games this season for the Dream, averaging 3.9 points, 1.7 rebounds and 3.5 assists in 23.4 minutes per game. Latta was waived by the Dream exactly one month ago on June 3 prior to the start of the regular season. She started 31 of 34 games for the Dream last season, averaging 11.4 points, 2.1 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game. Latta was active for the game on Friday but played only one minute in the Dream's victory.

DREAM SETS FRANCHISE RECORD FOR WINS

With Friday night's victory over the Washington Mystics, the Dream surpassed their total wins from a season ago, moving to 5-6 on the year. The Dream started last season 0-17 before finishing with a 4-30 record. They did not record their fourth win of the season until September 11.

DOUBLE DIGIT SCORERS

The Dream's three leading scorers (Lyttle, Holdsclaw, de Souza) have been consistent in their offensive production this season. Chamique Holdsclaw and Sancho Lyttle have currently scored in double figures in ten of eleven games this season. Holdsclaw holds the longest current streak of games in double figures with eight consecutive games. De Souza has scored in double figures in seven of eleven games.

THREE POINT WOES

While the Dream has been dominant inside this season, the team continues to have early season struggles from beyond the arc. Atlanta is currently giving up a league-worst 40.9% to opponents from three-point range. On the offensive end, the Dream are connecting on only 28.7% from three, which ranks 11th out of 13 teams in the league.

A BALANCED ATTACK

Currently nine Dream players are averaging double digits in minutes played and seven of those players are averaging over 15 minutes per game. Five different Dream players have led the team in scoring this season. Rookie Angel McCoughtry has been the Dream's most efficient player off the bench, averaging 9.8 points, 2.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists in 16.2 minutes per game. The Dream bench had it's most productive game of the season against Chicago on June 23, accounting for 55.1% of the Dream's total offense (54 of 98 points).

DREAM DOMINATING THE PAINT

The Atlanta Dream have outscored their opponents under the basket in eight out of the first eleven games of the season. This surge of inside scoring can be attributed to the duo of Sancho Lyttle (13.4 ppg, 6.5 rpg) and Erika de Souza (10.8 ppg, 7.6 rpg),

who are both close to averaging double-doubles. Lyttle and de Souza have two double-doubles each this season. Lyttle or de Souza has led the team in rebounding in nine of eleven games this season.

SUPERMAN IN THE BUILDING

NBA All-Star Dwight Howard of the Orlando Magic has been spotted at the last three Dream games. The Atlanta native is a big supporter of the WNBA and frequently attended Dream games last season. Other notables spotted at Philips Arena this summer include NBA legend Julius “Dr. J” Erving, Atlanta City Council President Lisa Borders and Atlanta Hawks forward Josh Smith.

MILESTONES FOR MIQUE

It took only 2 minutes and 37 seconds in Chamique Holdsclaw’s return to the WNBA on June 6 for the forward to reach another milestone in her WNBA career. Holdsclaw’s steal at the 7:23 minute mark in the first quarter against the Fever put her over the 300 mark for her career. After scoring 23 points during season opener, Holdsclaw was two points shy of 4,000. It would take only 1:46 into the first quarter for her to reach that milestone as she would make both free throws after being fouled by Monique Currie. Holdsclaw is only the ninth player in WNBA history to score more than 4,000 career points.

DREAM GETS A MAKEOVER

After finishing last season with a league worst 4-30 record, the Atlanta Dream overhauled the roster. With the return of Ivory Latta, the Dream’s roster now features five players returning from last year’s expansion team (Izi Castro Marques, Erika de Souza, Ivory Latta, Tamera Young, Jennifer Lacy). De Souza missed 22 games last season due to a fractured leg.

ALL-STAR RACE UNDERWAY

All-Star voting is officially underway. Four Dream players are candidates on the ballot, highlighted by six-time All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw (1999-2003, 2005). Also is two-time All-Star Michelle Snow (2005, 2006). Forwards Erika de Souza and Angel McCoughtry are both seeking their first appearance. Fans can cast their vote online or in arena now through July 7.

General Manager and Head Coach Marynell Meadors makes her fourth stop in the WNBA, bringing with her more than 35 years of coaching experience. Meadors enters her second season as General Manager and Head Coach of the Dream where she looks to turn around a team that finished 4-30 as an expansion team in 2008. As General Manager of the Dream, Meadors has made some notable acquisitions, including the signings of six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw and highly coveted free agent center Michelle Snow this offseason.

Prior to joining the Dream, Meadors spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the Washington Mystics. There she helped head coaches Richie Adubato and Tree Rollins to an aggregate record of 50-52, including a playoff appearance in 2006. Meadors aided the Mystics' rapid turnaround in 2007 when the squad narrowly missed the playoffs – they were eliminated on the final day of the season – after an 0-8 start.

Meadors also served as the first General Manager and Head Coach of the now-defunct Charlotte Sting where she led the franchise to the playoffs in each of its first two seasons. She also served as the Sting's director of player and staff personnel.

Following her tenure with the Sting, Meadors moved south where she was hired as the director of scouting for the Miami Sol. With the Sol, her responsibilities included advanced scouting of opponents and player evaluations for the WNBA Draft.

Meadors has an extensive background in the women's college game. For two seasons prior to joining the Mystics, she served as an assistant coach for the University of Pittsburgh, focusing her efforts on recruiting, scheduling, scouting, academics and community involvement.

Meadors was a head coach at Florida State and Tennessee Tech for a combined 30 years. At Florida State, she quickly turned the program around from three straight losing seasons prior to her arrival. The apex of her tenure came in 1991 when the Seminoles won the Metro Conference Championship and advanced to second round of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to Western Kentucky. A year earlier, she drove the Seminoles to the NCAA Tournament, though the squad was unable to advance past the opening round.

Before heading to Florida State, Meadors earned her stripes at Tennessee Tech where she won more than 300 games as head coach. She was the first head coach of the women's basketball program and in her 20 years at the helm, she posted a school-record .723 winning percentage. During her tenure, she received numerous accolades, including two Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year awards and a Metro Conference Coach of the Year award. While at Tennessee Tech, she steered her Golden Eagles squads to four OVC championships and two Metro Conference titles and became the first major women's college coach to win 350 games at one institution.
