TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

The Dream look to start off the 2009 season with a win against the Indiana Fever in tonight's home opener at Philips Arena. The Dream are 1-3 all-time against the Fever, who finished in fourth place in the Eastern Conference last season.

Few faces remain from last year's expansion team that finished 4-30. With the waiving of Ivory Latta bringing the Dream's roster to 11 players, only four returners are now on the roster. Three veterans—Chamique Holdsclaw, Nikki Teasley and Michelle Snow have been inserted into the expected starting lineup. Number one draft pick Angel McCoughtry is also expected to get playing time after an impressive pre-season.

The Dream were victorious in their only pre-season game, 76-73 against the Connecticut Sun. The Dream were led by new faces Holdsclaw (16 points, three rebounds) and Angel McCoughtry (14 points, two steals), and returning post Erika De Souza (16 pts. nine rebounds).

Indiana was the fourth and final team to make the playoffs last season out of the Eastern Conference, losing in the conference semi-finals to the eventual WNBA Champion Detroit Shock. The Fever have made the playoffs in each of the past three seasons, and are led by forwards Katie Douglas and Tamika Catchings. Catchings, who averaged 13 points and six rebounds last season, was a starter for the Eastern Conference in the last three All Star Games. Douglas led the Fever last season, averaging 16 points per game.

The Fever went 3-0 this preseason, winning against the Minnesota Lynx, Chicago Sky, and San Antonio Silver Stars. The Fever were led by forwards Tamika Catchings and Katie Douglas as the Fever's leading scorers averaged over ten points per game this preseason. Rookie first round draft pick Briann January out of Arizona State had a promising preseason, averaging eight points per game. January scored 12 points in the Fever's final preseason game at San Antonio, starting two out of three games.

Tonight's season opener will be the fifth time these two teams meet. The Fever are 2-0 at Philips Arena winning the two previous games 76-67 and 81-77. Tonight's game will feature a battle of University of Tennessee Alumni as Indiana's Catchings will face off against former college teammates Holdsclaw and Michelle Snow.

NEXT OPPONENT

The Dream will travel to the nation's capital tomorrow to take on the Washington Mystics. Atlanta lost all three matchups against the Mystics last season. Tip-off is scheduled for 4 pm ET at the Verizon Center.

NEWS AND NOTES

NUMBER ONES: ROOKIE MCCOUGHTRY AND VET HOLDSCLAW START STRONG

The Atlanta Dream's busy offseason looks like it could pay dividends in 2009. Two Dream players are former number one picks in the WNBA Draft and both are off to good starts. Veteran Chamique Holdsclaw (the #1 pick in the 1999 draft) and 2009 number one draft pick Angel McCoughtry had promising performances in the team's one and only pre-season game against the Connecticut Sun. Holdsclaw had 16 points, three rebounds and two blocks in 25 minutes, while McCoughtry scored 14 points and made an impact on defense, recording two steals in her WNBA debut.

DREAM WAIVES IVORY LATTA; FINALIZES ROSTER

The Atlanta Dream finalized their eleven-player roster, releasing last season's starting point guard Ivory Latta. Latta, a three-year veteran out of the University of North Carolina, led the team in assists last season and finished second in scoring. The roster move was the last before Friday's 3 p.m. EST deadline, when all WNBA teams had to cut down to 11 players. The Dream also waived center Chantelle Anderson and forward Marlies Gipson midway through training camp.

DE SOUZA RETURNS TO FORM

Erika De Souza, one of four returning players from last season's inaugural roster, picked up where she left off last season with a strong pre-season performance against the Connecticut Sun. Injury was the only thing that slowed De Souza last season, as she put up the best numbers of her career but only played 12 games due to a fractured leg. Against Connecticut, De Souza finished the game one rebound shy of a double-double, scoring 16 points and hauling in nine rebounds. De Souza also had a blocked shot and a steal and was named the Comcast Player of the Game.

HISTORY SAYS HOLDSCLAW COMES TO PLAY OPENING NIGHT

The Atlanta Dream's biggest offseason acquisition, six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw, holds the WNBA record for rebounds in a season opener. Holdsclaw collected 24 rebounds in the 2003 season opener when the Washington Mystics started the season on the road at the Charlotte Sting. Holdsclaw also holds the sixth highest points total in a season opener with 29 when the Mystics started the 2000 season in Orlando.

DREAM GETS A MAKEOVER

After finishing last season with a league worst 4-30 record, the Atlanta Dream overhauled the roster. The Dream's roster now features just four players returning from last year's expansion team. Replacing them is a mixture of free agent signees, draft picks and notable veterans. Iziane Castro-Marques, Erika De Souza, Tamera Young and Jennifer Lacy are the only returning players, as the Dream look to rebound from last season's dismal record. De Souza, who is projected to be a starter, missed 22 games last season while plagued by injury.

LADY BULLDOG COCO MILLER RETURNS TO GEORGIA

The Dream's latest free agent acquisition is former University of Georgia standout guard Coco Miller. Miller spent her first eight seasons in the league with the

Washington Mystics where she averaged six points, two rebounds and one assist per game. She appeared in all 34 games with the Mystics last season, including six starts while averaging five points per game. In 2002, Miller was named the WNBA's Most Improved Player.

LOCAL YMCA IS RECIPIENT OF "DREAM" COURT

Last week, Head Coach Marynell Meadors, several Dream players and City Council President Lisa Borders gathered together in the Joseph B. Whitehead Memorial Branch of the Butler Street YMCA on June 2 for the unveiling of the center's brand new basketball court. The court, now adorned in Dream Blue and Red, was awarded to the Butler Street YMCA following a nationwide competition called the "Discover® Card Home Court Challenge," which took place in August 2008. Hundreds of youth basketball players from select WNBA markets took place in the completion which Atlanta won. The Dream then selected the Butler Street YMCA as the recipient of the new court.

NEW OFFSEASON ADDITION GETS ABOVE THE RIM

Michelle Snow, one of the Dream's big offseason signees, was seen dunking at the Dream's Media Day. The footage was posted on YouTube last week. Snow averaged ten points and seven rebounds per game last season with the Houston Comets. Snow signed with the Dream in February, and looks to go back to the WNBA All Star game again this season. Lisa Leslie and Candace Parker are the only two players in league history to have dunked in a regular season game.

General Manager and Head Coach Marynell Meadors makes her fourth stop in the WNBA, bringing with her more than 35 years of coaching experience. Meadors enters her second season as General Manager and Head Coach of the Dream where she looks to turn around a team that finished 4-30 as an expansion team in 2008. As General Manager of the Dream, Meadors has made some notable acquisitions, including the signings of six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw and highly coveted free agent center Michelle Snow this offseason.

Prior to joining the Dream, Meadors spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the Washington Mystics. There she helped head coaches Richie Adubato and Tree Rollins to an aggregate record of 50-52, including a playoff appearance in 2006. Meadors aided the Mystics' rapid turnaround in 2007 when the squad narrowly missed the playoffs – they were eliminated on the final day of the season – after an 0-8 start.

Meadors also served as the first General Manager and Head Coach of the now-defunct Charlotte Sting where she led the franchise to the playoffs in each of its first two seasons. She also served as the Sting's director of player and staff personnel.

Following her tenure with the Sting, Meadors moved south where she was hired as the director of scouting for the Miami Sol. With the Sol, her responsibilities included advanced scouting of opponents and player evaluations for the WNBA Draft.

Meadors has an extensive background in the women's college game. For two seasons prior to joining the Mystics, she served as an assistant coach for the University of Pittsburgh, focusing her efforts on recruiting, scheduling, scouting, academics and community involvement.

Meadors was a head coach at Florida State and Tennessee Tech for a combined 30 years. At Florida State, she quickly turned the program around from three straight losing seasons prior to her arrival. The apex of her tenure came in 1991 when the Seminoles won the Metro Conference Championship and advanced to second round of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to Western Kentucky. A year earlier, she drove the Seminoles to the NCAA Tournament, though the squad was unable to advance past the opening round.

Before heading to Florida State, Meadors earned her stripes at Tennessee Tech where she won more than 300 games as head coach. She was the first head coach of the women's basketball program and in her 20 years at the helm, she posted a school-record .723 winning percentage. During her tenure, she received numerous accolades, including two Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year awards and a Metro Conference Coach of the Year award. While at Tennessee Tech, she steered her Golden Eagles squads to four OVC championships and two Metro Conference titles and became the first major women's college coach to win 350 games at one institution.
