TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

The Dream, who posted a record of 4-30 in last year's inaugural season, look to start things off right in 2009 with a preseason matchup against the Connecticut Sun. The Dream lost all three of their matchups against the Sun last season, who reached the playoffs with a record of 21-13. Nine of the 14 players on the Dream's training camp roster will make their debut in Dream uniform tonight. They are headlined by six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw, free agent signee Michelle Snow and number one draft pick Angel McCoughtry. Only five players were on last year's roster: Iziane Castro Marques, Erika De Souza, Jennifer Lacy, Ivory Latta and Tamera Young.

Connecticut has made the playoffs the last six consecutive seasons, including WNBA Finals appearances in 2004 and 2005. The Sun are led by Lindsay Whalen, who was named to the All-WNBA First Team in 2008, while finishing second in the MVP Voting. Asjha Jones led the Sun in scoring last season averaging 17 points per game, while averaging six rebounds and two assists per game.

This is the second pre-season game for the Sun (1-0). Connecticut defeated the New York Liberty 74-62 at home in their first matchup. Asjha Jones led the way with 11 points as 15 players saw action in the Sun's victory. Kerri Gardin added nine points and five rebounds and rookie Chante Black chipped in with eight points and seven rebounds.

Tonight's matchup is the fourth overall meeting between the two teams, and so far Connecticut has had the upper hand, winning the previous three matchups 100-67, 109-101, and 98-72.

NEXT OPPONENT

The Dream tip-off the regular season at home Saturday, June 6 against the Indiana Fever. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Philips Arena. Atlanta went 1-3 last season against the Fever, winning their only matchup on the road.

NEWS AND NOTES

FORMER TENNESSEE STANDOUTS TEAMMATES AGAIN

The Dream had a busy offseason in 2009, highlighted by the acquisition of former University of Tennessee standouts Chamique Holdsclaw and Michelle Snow.

Holdsclaw announced in April that she would end her retirement from the WNBA to sign with the Dream. The Dream originally acquired her rights in December from the Los Angeles Sparks, in exchange for the 13th pick in the 2008 draft. She has earned numerous accolades in her career including six All-Star appearances, Rookie of the Year honors, an Olympic gold medal and WNBA All-Decade honorable mention.

Snow, an All-Star center and one of the top available free agents this offseason, looks to reconnect with her former college teammate. She averaged 9.9 points and 6.8 rebounds for the Comets last season.

LADY BULLDOG COCO MILLER RETURNS TO GEORGIA

The Dream's latest free agent acquisition is former University of Georgia standout guard Coco Miller. Miller spent her first eight seasons in the league with the Washington Mystics where she averaged six points, two rebounds and one assist per game. She appeared in all 34 games with the Mystics last season, including six starts while averaging five points per game. In 2002, Miller was named the WNBA's Most Improved Player.

NEW LOOK DREAM

In tonight's pre-season game, Coach Meadors will experiment with different lineups as the coaching staff gets its first chance to evaluate the new roster against game competition. The Dream has completely revamped their roster this offseason, returning just five players from last year's expansion squad. Guards Iziane Castro Marques, Ivory Latta and Tamera Young, and forwards Erika De Souza and Jennifer Lacy are the only holdovers. Making their debut for the Dream are some notable offseason acquisitions including, six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw, number one draft pick Angel McCoughtry, Michelle Snow (free agent) and Sancho Lyttle (dispersal draft). Center Chantelle Anderson (torn ACL) and point guard Nikki Teasley (pregnancy) also make their Dream debut tonight after missing last season.

NEW OFFSEASON ADDITION GETS ABOVE THE RIM

Michelle Snow, one of the Dream's big offseason signees, was seen dunking at the Dream's Media Day. The footage was posted on YouTube last week. Snow averaged ten points and seven rebounds per game last season with the Houston Comets. Snow signed with the Dream in February, and looks to go back to the WNBA All Star game

again this season. Lisa Leslie and Candace Parker are the only two players in league history to have dunked in a regular season game.

ROOKIE CLASS READY TO IMPRESS

Dream rookies Angel McCoughtry, Shalee Lehning, and Marlies Gipson make their WNBA debuts in tonight's game. McCoughtry, the first overall pick in this year's draft out of Louisville, led the Big East in scoring last season averaging 23 points per game. McCoughtry was named to the first team all American squad and was named the Big East Defensive Player of the Year, averaging four steals per game. Former Kansas State teammates Lehning and Gipson are looking to take their game to the next level. Lehning, a 5-9 point guard, averaged ten points, seven rebounds, and seven assists last season at Kansas State. Gipson, a 6-0 forward, was a four-year starter and averaged 13.2 points and 6.7 rebounds as a senior.

DREAM TO WEBCAST 32 GAMES LIVE THIS SEASON

The Atlanta Dream announced earlier this month the team's 2009 broadcast schedule, highlighted by a national television appearance on ESPN2 and the live webcast of 32 Dream games throughout the 2009 season. With the launch of WNBA LiveAccess, Dream fans will gain live access to games via www.AtlantaDream.net.

DREAM AT HOME IN NEW PRACTICE FACILITY

In May, the Atlanta Dream and the Suwanee Sports Academy announced a new partnership agreement that made Suwanee Sports Academy the Dream's official practice facility. The Sports Academy is the largest privately owned facility in the country for basketball training and competitive events, featuring seven NBA regulation basketball courts.

General Manager and Head Coach Marynell Meadors makes her fourth stop in the WNBA, bringing with her more than 35 years of coaching experience. Meadors enters her second season as General Manager and Head Coach of the Dream where she looks to turn around a team that finished 4-30 as an expansion team in 2008. As General Manager of the Dream, Meadors has made some notable acquisitions, including the signings of six-time WNBA All-Star Chamique Holdsclaw and highly coveted free agent center Michelle Snow this offseason.

Prior to joining the Dream, Meadors spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the Washington Mystics. There she helped head coaches Richie Adubato and Tree Rollins to an aggregate record of 50-52, including a playoff appearance in 2006. Meadors aided the Mystics' rapid turnaround in 2007 when the squad narrowly missed the playoffs – they were eliminated on the final day of the season – after an 0-8 start.

Meadors also served as the first General Manager and Head Coach of the now-defunct Charlotte Sting where she led the franchise to the playoffs in each of its first two seasons. She also served as the Sting's director of player and staff personnel.

Following her tenure with the Sting, Meadors moved south where she was hired as the director of scouting for the Miami Sol. With the Sol, her responsibilities included advanced scouting of opponents and player evaluations for the WNBA Draft.

Meadors has an extensive background in the women's college game. For two seasons prior to joining the Mystics, she served as an assistant coach for the University of Pittsburgh, focusing her efforts on recruiting, scheduling, scouting, academics and community involvement.

Meadors was a head coach at Florida State and Tennessee Tech for a combined 30 years. At Florida State, she quickly turned the program around from three straight losing seasons prior to her arrival. The apex of her tenure came in 1991 when the Seminoles won the Metro Conference Championship and advanced to second round of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to Western Kentucky. A year earlier, she drove the Seminoles to the NCAA Tournament, though the squad was unable to advance past the opening round.

Before heading to Florida State, Meadors earned her stripes at Tennessee Tech where she won more than 300 games as head coach. She was the first head coach of the women's basketball program and in her 20 years at the helm, she posted a school-record .723 winning percentage. During her tenure, she received numerous accolades, including two Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year awards and a Metro Conference Coach of the Year award. While at Tennessee Tech, she steered her Golden Eagles squads to four OVC championships and two Metro Conference titles and became the first major women's college coach to win 350 games at one institution.
