Primary Responsibilities – Game Operations:

- Assist game operations staff in securing talent for National Anthem and halftime performances, as well as concourse entertainment (i.e. pep bands, face painters).
- Compiling and updating contact lists of local performers, music executives, etc.
- Actively contribute creative ideas for in-game contests and entertainment.
- Help to manage mascot, dance team, in-arena host and other game talent.
- Execute game presentation initiatives on game days; assist in preparing all game day props, equipment, etc.
- Other responsibilities as designated.

Primary Responsibilities – New Media:

- Help to manage daily content of the official website, WashingtonMystics.com.
- Assist with collecting and posting original content for the website including podcasts, player features, pre- and post-game interviews, etc.; actively contribute creative ideas for web features.
- Conduct research on latest online innovations and features by viewing other sites (both sport and non-sport).
