MEDIA INFORMATION

Welcome to the seventh season of San Antonio Silver Stars basketball. The Silver Stars media services department is here to serve you and will accommodate your needs as best as we can. We want to offer the best possible service to all of our media affiliates. The following are a few guidelines we hope will assist you in your coverage this season.

CREDENTIALS

The only season credentials honored for admission to the AT&T Center are WNBA Media Passes, Silver Stars season credentials and Silver Stars single game credentials. Each of these credentials will admit the bearer to the AT&T Center, media workroom, media hospitality room, press row and both locker rooms.

Media credentials will be issued by the Silver Stars media services department and will be issued prior to the start of the WNBA season for those media who regularly cover the team. Individual single game press passes can be secured by accredited members of the media by emailing or calling the Silver Stars media services office no later than 10 a.m. the day of a game and by 5 p.m. on Friday for a Saturday or Sunday game. Single game credentials can be picked up at the will call window located at the Southeast Ticket Tower of the AT&T Center two hours prior to tip-off.

All international requests are handled by the WNBA International PR Department. Any international media member interested in covering a Silver Stars game must first submit a request in writing to the WNBA. INTERVIEWS

All interview requests for the San Antonio Silver Stars should be directed to Leigh Anne Gullett. All Silver Stars practices are open to the media. In regards to game-day shootarounds, the session will be open the last 15 minutes of the workout. On game days players are generally available for 30 minutes ending one hour before the start of a game (e.g., media access shall be granted from 5:30-6 p.m. for a 7 p.m. game). Locker rooms are re-opened to the media after the game following a 10-minute cooling off period and will remain open for 30 minutes. Only working members of the press with valid credentials will be admitted into the locker rooms.

MEDIA ENTRANCE AND PARKING

The media entrance is located at the Southeast VIP entrance of the AT&T Center. All media members must enter the building through this entrance. WNBA and Silver Stars season passes will be honored and single game credentials will be left at the will call window for pickup. The press doors open two hours prior to tip off. For those media members who receive season parking privileges, the media parking is located in Lot 4. For those media covering Silver Stars on a game-by-game basis please call the Silver Stars media services department at (210) 444-5738 to arrange parking needs.

MEDIA WORKROOM

The media workroom and media hospitality room are located on the event level in the southeast corner of the AT&T Center, and are accessible only with a valid credential. The rooms open two hours prior to game time. The media workroom is equipped with electrical outlets and telephones. For additional phone needs please call Shane Skaggs at (210) 444-5153. Game notes, media guides, running sheets and other relevant information will be available in the media workroom prior to the game. In addition, play-by-play sheets, halftime and final box scores, and post-game notes and quotes will be placed in the media workroom after the game.

COURTSIDE

All members of the media will be seated at either the courtside press table or in the overflow press seating located on the Plaza Level in sections 101-103 and 126-128. All seats are reserved with an appropriate name tag for all members of the media placed in that section. There are electrical outlets at all locations and telephones are located at various points along press row. In addition, stat monitors, which also show the in-house TV feed, are available on press row. It would be appreciated if post-game stories could be written and filed in the media workroom to facilitate any changeover activities in the AT&T Center.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

The photography areas of the AT&T Center are located along the baselines on both ends of the court. Photographers are asked to keep off the sideline areas in front of or behind the team benches and in front of press row. In addition, please observe WNBA rules for player escape routes—an open area approximately five feet on both sides of the basket. Only television and photographers doing post-game interviews will have access to the locker rooms. Photographers are asked to use rubber lens shades for their cameras.

TV/RADIO PLAY-BY-PLAY

Andrew Monaco enters his seventh season as the “Voice of the Silver Stars.” A year-round fixture at the AT&T Center, Monaco also handles sideline reporting duties on San Antonio Spurs broadcasts.

Prior to joining the Spurs Sports & Entertainment family, Monaco spent four seasons as the radio play-by-play announcer for the now-defunct Orlando Miracle. He also handled TV play-by-play duties on select Orlando Magic broadcasts and was a host/sideline reporter for the Magic and Miami Heat. He has worked for FSN, Sunshine Network and Comcast, handling TV play-by-play coverage of college

football, men’s and women’s basketball and college baseball. From 1990-95, he was the radio play-by-play announcer for the Orlando Cubs and the Orlando SunRays baseball teams. Monaco and his wife, Laura, have a son, Drew, and a daughter, Gina.

He is a former studio host and pre- and post-game host for the San Antonio Spurs as well. During the last 12 years, Everett has hosted the La Cantera Golf Show every Saturday morning at 8 a.m. on KTKR-AM/Ticket 760. He

currently hosts a sports talk show weekday mornings with Peter Burns on KTKR-AM/Ticket 760. Everett and his wife, Lori, have four children, all of whom enjoy attending Silver Stars games.
