2008 SEASON NOTES

San Antonio finished the 2008 season with a league- and franchise-best 24-10 record. The Silver Stars were a perfect 14-0 against Eastern Conference teams during the regular season. Their 24-10 mark and unblemished record against the East secured home court advantage throughout the playoffs for the Silver Stars.

The Silver Stars opened the playoffs with a three-game series against Sacramento, winning on the road and splitting at home to advance to the Western Conference Finals against the Los Angeles Sparks. After falling to the Sparks in L.A., the Stars evened things up in Game Two at the AT&T Center after **Sophia Young** launched a buzzer-beating miracle shot for the win. The following day, San Antonio pulled out a game three victory for the franchise's first Western Conference Championship and a trip to the WNBA Finals.

An injury depleted roster and six tough games on the road to the Finals left San Antonio vulnerable to a tough, experienced Detroit squad. The Shock claimed the three-game sweep, easily winning twice in San Antonio and claiming their third WNBA Championship on their home floor in Detroit.

Following the regular season, **Sophia Young** earned first-team all-WNBA honors and first-team all-defensive honors. **Becky Hammon** picked up a second-team all-WNBA nod and Vickie Johnson claimed her first Kim Perrot Sportsmanship Award.

San Antonio's big three—Hammon, Young and **Ann Wauters**—all ranked among the top 20 in the league for scoring average with Hammon claiming the sixth spot at 17.6 points per game. Young fell right behind her at 17.5 points per game and Wauters averaged 14.7 points per game, good enough for 18th in the WNBA. All three players also earned Player of the Week honors at different points throughout the season.

Becky Hammon and **Vickie Johnson** played their 260th career game together against Connecticut on Sept. 11, for the third-most games played as teammates in the WNBA. Hammon and Johnson's playing days date back to 1999 when they were both with the New York Liberty until Johnson joined San Antonio prior to the 2006 season. Hammon rejoined Johnson in San Antonio in 2007.

On July 27, Vickie Johnson became the eighth player in WNBA history to score 4,000 points. She is the only player in league history to have collected 4,000 points, 1,000 rebounds and 1,000 assists in a career.

Becky Hammon's six assists against the Washington Mystics on July 8 sent her career total over 800 to make her the seventh player in WNBA history to reach 3,000 points and 800 assists, joining Vickie Johnson, Shannon Johnson, Sheryl Swoopes, Tamecka Dixon, Katie Smith and Andrea Stinson.

Becky Hammon went 14 of 15 from the free throw line July 8 against New York to break a franchise record for free throws made in a game. The previous mark was set by Kim Williams in 1997 with 13 against Los Angeles.
