MINNESOTA LYNX (2-1)

SERIES NOTES

- The Mercury and Lynx meet for the first time ever in the postseason. This marks Minnesota's first trip to the Western Conference Finals.
- Phoenix is making its third consecutive trip to the Western Conference Finals.
- The Mercury has advanced to the Western Conference Finals in each of its last four postseason appearances (did not qualify for the postseason in 2008).
- The Mercury is making its sixth Conference Finals appearance, third most in WNBA history (8, Los Angeles and New York)
- The Mercury has advanced past the first round in five of its seven postseason appearances all-time.
- Minnesota won the 2011 regular season series with Phoenix (3-2) for the first time since 2004 and just the third time in franchise history.
- The first and third highest scoring teams in the WNBA combined to averaged 187.0 points in five meetings this season.
- The first meeting, a 112-105 Mercury win in Minnesota, was the highest scoring regulation game in WNBA history.
- The Mercury, the league's most potent offense for a sixth straight season, averaged 91.6 points per game against the Lynx in 2011.
- Diana Taurasi, the league's top scorer for a fourth straight season, averaged 23.2 points vs. Minnesota this season.

MERCURY 77 Storm 75	KeyArena Seattle, Washington	Seattle, WA- In the decisive Game 3 the Mercury overcame an abysmal first quarter and an 18-point deficit in the second to knock off the defending champion Storm and advance to its third consecutive Western Conference Finals. The win was Phoenix's first in Key Arena since Sept. 10, 2009. Seattle held the league's best offense to just nine first-quarter points on 3-of-11 shooting and forced nine turnovers, but Phoenix crawled its way back into the game cutting the deficit to just nine by halftime. The situation seemed dire when Diana Taurasi fouled out of the neck-and-neck game with 6:38 remaining, but Penny Taylor scored 11 of her 19 points in the game's final six minutes to lead the Mercury. With 14 seconds remaining and the game tied at 75-75, Taylor drove baseline and missed the go-ahead basket, but the rebound charmed out to Candice Dupree who sank a 6-footer with 1.9 seconds on the clock to seal the win. Taylor also contributed a franchise postseason-record 17 rebounds in the game.

Storm 83 MERCURY 92	US Airways Center Phoenix, Arizona	Phoenix, AZ- Seattle guard Sue Bird said it best in her postgame comments referring to the contrast in Game 1 and Game 2: "I think you saw two different games." In Game 2, Phoenix emerged with a fighter's heart dominating the interior, a place the Storm has used as a key to victory over the Mercury. Led by Candice Dupree's game-high 29 points and franchise-record-tying 12 made field goals (12-of-14), the Mercury outscored the Storm 58-12 in the paint and out-rebounded Seattle by 13, led by DeWanna Bonner's game-high 13. Phoenix never trailed in the contest and started the fourth quarter with a 10-4 run taking an 81-66 lead, its largest of the game. The league's most potent offense up 92, its most against Seattle, the league's stingiest defense, since July 1, 2009. Phoenix improved to 9-3 all-time in postseason series elimination games and 5-1 at home. Penny Taylor added 12 points and six rebounds. Diana Taurasi finished with 26 points, four rebounds and three assists.

MERCURY 61 Storm 80	Key Arena Seattle, Washington	Seattle, WA- The Seattle Storm dominated every facet of Game 1 of the Western Conference Semifinals, holding the league's most potent offense to just 61 points, its lowest in a postseason game since Game 1 of the 1998 WNBA Finals, and a 29.7 percent shooting clip, its worst of 2011. Controlling the interior was key for the Storm, which out-rebounded the Mercury 49-35, grabbed 15 offensive rebounds for 20 second chance points and outscored Phoenix 40-20 in the paint. DeWanna Bonner had the best all around game for the Mercury with 10 points and a team-high eight rebounds. Penny Taylor , who missed five of the previous six Mercury games, led the team with 13 points. Diana Taurasi finished with 11. The five Phoenix starters combined to shoot just 18-of-55 (.327) from the field. The Mercury, which did not record one quarter of 20 or more points, was outscored 29-11 in the third quarter, trailing by as many as 27, a deficit that ballooned to a game-high 29 after the first possession in the fourth.

2011 QUICK NOTES

MERCURY PLAYOFF QUICK NOTES

- The Mercury finished in **THIRD** place in the Western Conference and is making its **THIRD** straight postseason appearance and **FOURTH** in the last **FIVE** years.
- Phoenix faced Seattle in the postseason for the **SECOND** straight year and the **THIRD** time in franchise history (**2007**)... Phoenix swept the 2007 Western Conference Semifinals
- **The winner of the Phoenix-Seattle matchup has won the title each time the two teams have met in the postseason**
- Head Coach **COREY GAINES** is the franchise's winningest coach in the postseason (**11-7**) and has been a part of **TWO** championship seasons (assistant under **PAUL WESTHEAD** in 2007).
- The Mercury is **10-3** all-time in postseason series elimination games and **2-0** in 2011... **6-1** all-time at home in such games.
- **DIANA TAURASI** is **8-1** in elimination games for her career and **6-1** at US Airways Center in such games.
- The Mercury is **4-3** all-time in Game 3 situations and **2-2** on the road.
- Phoenix has only **ONCE** been eliminated from the postseason in a Game 3 (1998 WNBA Finals)... The Mercury has won a series in Game 3 **THREE** times (2009 Western Conference Semifinals, 2009 Western Conference Finals, 2011 Western Conference Semifinals)
- The Mercury is **12-6** at home all-time in the postseason
- The Mercury was **10-3** during the 2011 regular season when playing on one day of rest, fitting for the playoffs that have had Phoenix playing every other day.

WESTERN CONFERENCE FINALS QUICK NOTES

- The Mercury is making its **THIRD** straight Western Conference Finals appearance and **FOURTH** in the last **FIVE** seasons.
- Phoenix has advanced to the Western Conference Finals in each of its last **FOUR** postseason appearances (did not qualify for the playoffs in 2008).
- The Mercury has appeared in the Conference Finals **SIX** times in franchise history, **THIRD** most in WNBA history (8, LA and NY)
- The Mercury has made it out of the first round in **FIVE** of its **SEVEN** postseason trips (1997, one-game elimination; 2000).
- **To advance to the WNBA Finals, the Mercury will have to knock off the defending WNBA champions and the reigning regular season champions... Will become the FIRST team to do so in WNBA history.**
- The Mercury is looking to become the **FIRST** No. 3 seed to advance to the WNBA Finals and the lowest seed in the Western Conference to ever advance to the Finals (two No. 4 seeds in the East have advanced: 2001 Charlotte, 2010 Atlanta)

REGULAR SEASON QUICK NOTES

- The Mercury finished 2011 with **19** wins, **ONE** shy of its **FOURTH** 20-win season in franchise history and **THIRD** in the last **FIVE** years.
- Since 2007 the Mercury has averaged **19.2** wins per season, **THIRD** most in the WNBA (**Seattle-21.4**, **Indiana-20.4**).
- The Mercury won **EIGHT** of its last **14** games, recovering from a streak of **FIVE** losses in **SIX** outings from **July 20-Aug. 7**.
- **FOUR** of Phoenix's last **EIGHT** wins came against West playoff contending teams (Minnesota, Seattle, San Antonio, LA)
- The Mercury finished **9-8** in its last **17** games with **12** of those **17** games coming against 2011 playoff teams.
- **FIVE** of Phoenix's last **EIGHT** losses came by a combined **17** points, including **TWO** games decided in overtime.
- Phoenix defeated the West's best team **THREE** times this season (**June 21 at San Antonio**, **July 13 at Minnesota**, **August 9 vs. Minnesota**).

MERCURY OFFENSE NOTES

- Phoenix led the league in scoring (**89.0**) for the **SIXTH** consecutive season. No other team averaged more than **83.0** points per game.
- The Mercury led the league in field goal percentage, shooting **46.1** percent from the field... **THIRD** straight season shooting better than 46 percent from the field
- Phoenix led the WNBA in free throw percentage (**.851**)... **SECOND** best clip in franchise history (**.855**, **2009**).
- **JULY 1**: Franchise record **42** made free throws (**42-of-45**, **.933**)

MERCURY PLAYER QUICK NOTES (see individual player bios for more 2011 notes)

- **DIANA TAURASI**, **PENNY TAYLOR** and **CANDICE DUPREE** combined to average **52.9** points per game during the regular season, more than any trio in the WNBA
- **TAYLOR** and **TAURASI** each ranked in the top 12 in the league in assists: (Taylor-**SEVENTH**, Taurasi-**12th**)
- **TAYLOR** and **DUPREE** each ranked in the top 20 in the league in rebounding (Dupree-**FIFTH**, TAYLOR-**20th**)

- **DUPREE** has missed just **ONE** game in her five-plus year career (Aug. 3, 2007, family emergency).
- **DUPREE** has started **EVERY** game she has played in since being permanently inserted into the Chicago Sky starting lineup **June 4, 2006** (**SIXTH** game of her career).
- **DIANA TAURASI** led the league in scoring for the **FOURTH** straight season and the **FIFTH** time in the last **SIX** years.

- **TAURASI** scored 20 or more points **23** times in 2011, including **12** of her last **14** games.
- Since the beginning of August, **TAURASI** averaged **23.8** points per game.

- **PENNY TAYLOR** recorded **TWO** double-doubles in 2011, **ONE** with points and rebounds, **ONE** with points and assists... **ONE** of just **THREE** players in the league to accomplish the feat this season.

- In **FIVE** starts this season: **16.4** points, **8.6** rebounds
- **FOUR** different Mercury players were named Player of the Week in 2011 (**Dupree, Taylor, Taurasi, Bonner**)... **MOST** from one team in WNBA history
- **AUGUST 30:** Head Coach **COREY GAINES (73-63)** became the winningest coach in Phoenix Mercury franchise history, surpassing **CHERYL MILLER (70-52)**.

TRADING FAST?

Yes, with the addition of **KARA BRAXTON** in July 2010 the Mercury gained an interior presence worth 10.6 points and 4.9 rebounds a game, but they may have sacrificed the very thing that has identified this franchise since 2006: speed. In an effort to get the 6-6, 225-pound center involved, the up-tempo Mercury turned down the throttle a bit and here was the result: fewer possessions, fewer shots and more turnovers:

WNBA CAREER NOTES

- The all-time winningest head coach in Phoenix Mercury franchise history. Surpassed Cheryl Miller Aug. 30, 2011 with his 71st career win.
- Became just the second head coach to win 50 games at the helm of the Mercury on July 29 vs. Minnesota (Cheryl Miller).
- Guided the Mercury to the 2009 WNBA Championship in just his second season as head coach.
- After narrowly missing the postseason in his first season as head coach, led the Mercury to becoming the first team in the WNBA to clinch a spot in the 2009 WNBA Playoffs.
- Earned a career-best six-game win streak from July 1-18, 2009.
- Led the Mercury to a 28-22 (.560) record through his first 50 games as Head Coach.
- Finished first WNBA season as head coach with a 16-18 record.
- Earned first WNBA win on June 3, 2008 vs. Washington (98-93).
- Named the seventh head coach in franchise history on November 7, 2007.
- Was top assistant in charge of an offense that set WNBA records for scoring average in both 2006 (87.1) and 2007 (89.0).

- Learned fastbreak offense from **Paul Westhead**, his coach at Loyola Marymount University from 1986-88.
- As the starting point guard, led the Lions to a 26-game win streak his senior season.
- Holds a school-record for career three-point field goal percentage (.506) and assist average (8.7).
- Originally selected by the Seattle Supersonics in the third round (65th overall) of the 1988 NBA Draft.
- Spent five seasons with five different NBA teams, earning a trip to the 1994 NBA Finals with the New York Knicks.
- Played 12 seasons internationally, including a stint as the starting point guard with Scalavini in Italy.
- Served as a player/assistant coach under Westhead with the ABA's Long Beach Jam in 2003 before taking over as head coach and leading the team to a championship.
