LAST TIME OUT – SEPT. 9 vs TULSA

LOS ANGELES (AP) Jantel Lavender had 19 points and a season-high 12 rebounds, and the Los Angeles Sparks beat the Tulsa Shock 84-73 on Friday night.

The Sparks (14-19) snapped a two-game losing streak and won for only the second time in six games despite missing leading scorer and rebounder Candace Parker, who sat out for precautionary reasons after her right knee flared up.

Ticha Penicheiro scored 13 points and Kristi Toliver added 12 for the Sparks.

Andrea Riley and Liz Cambage each scored 18 points for the Shock (3-30), who lost their fifth straight game.

Starting in place of Parker, Lavender scored 13 points in the first half. She sat out a long stretch of the second half after she picked up her fourth and fifth fouls in an 18-second span in the third quarter.

The Sparks led from 6-4 and didn't let the Shock come within single digits in the fourth quarter. They avenged an Aug. 26 loss to Tulsa in which the Shock snapped a WNBA-record, 20-game losing streak.

"We wanted to have revenge, but we just knew we had to go out and play hard," Lavender said.

"We knew they were going to come in and play with some kind of confidence because they did beat us and we were a part of three wins for the season. We just had to come out and play hard tonight because they are a good team and play well together."

Lavender had no points in three of her previous four games and reached double-digit scoring for the second time in 10 games.

"She worked well on the pick-and-roll set because she rolls deep to the basket," Sparks coach Joe Bryant said. "It was good for her."

Bryant said Parker will be a game-time decision for the Sparks' season finale Saturday.

"We're not in the playoffs, so it's really caring more about the player," Bryant said. "It's important for her to get a full recovery."

Parker missed 15 games with torn cartilage in her right knee earlier this season. She is averaging 18.9 points and a team-leading 8.9 rebounds.

Tulsa was also without its leading scorer, point guard Ivory Latta, who is out for the rest of the season with a torn meniscus in her left knee. She was averaging 12.2 points.

SPARKS vs TULSA GAME NOTES

- With a driving layup at the 08:29 mark in the game's second quarter, Sparks guard Noelle Quinn notched her 1,000th career-point.
 - The Los Angeles native finished the game with seven points, bringing her career total to 1,006.
- Leading the Sparks was rookie center Jantel Lavender in her second career start.
 - The No. 5 overall pick in the 2011 WNBA Draft made her first five buckets and finished the game with 19 points on 8-for-12 shooting and a career-best 12 rebounds.
 - She becomes the third Spark and second WNBA rookie to register multiple double doubles this season.
 - Tulsa's Liz Cambage has three.
 - Tulsa will try to avoid finishing with more losses than any team in league history by winning at home on Sunday against the Silver Stars.
- Los Angeles went 4-1 against the Shock this season.
 - The Sparks now lead the overall series 20-11 and have won nine of their last 10 games against the Shock.
- With 18 points apiece, the Shock were led by former Spark Andrea Riley and rookie center Liz Cambage.
 - Riley was drafted by the Sparks in 2010 and was traded to the Shock in exchange for a 2012 second-round pick.
- Among the crowd at STAPLES Center was actor/comedian Jack Black who performed the National Anthem and took part in a pregame fundraiser to support the 24th Street Theatre Company.
- Following the game, The Africa Channel and African Ancestry held an on-court ceremony in which the African heritage of DeLisha Milton-Jones and Ebony Hoffman were revealed. Milton-Jones traces her maternal ancestry to Nigeria while Hoffman's roots are in Sierra Leone.

SERIES NOTES AND TEAM CONNECTIONS

- On June 1, the Sparks traded forward Lindsay Wisdom-Hylton to the Chicago Sky in exchange for a second round pick in the 2012 WNBA Draft
- Sparks forward Tina Thompson and Sky guard Dominique Canty played together with the Houston Comets from 2003-06
 - Thompson spent the first 12 years of her WNBA career with the Houston Comets, leading them to the first four WNBA Championships in league history, then signed with LA when the Comets were disbanded after the 2008 season
 - Canty was signed by Chicago via free agency in February 2007
 - Thompson was also teammate with Sky forward Michelle Snow from 2002-2008
- On May 13, 2010 the Chicago Sky traded Kristi Toliver to the Los Angeles Sparks in exchange for a 2011 second-round pick
 - Toliver was selected third overall by the Chicago Sky in the 2009 WNBA Draft
- Sparks forward Ebony Hoffman and Sky guard Shay Murphy were teammates at USC in 2003-04

LAST TIME AGAINST CHICAGO (7/30)

ROSEMONT, Ill. (AP) DeLisha Milton-Jones scored 19 points and made a pair of clinching free throws as the Los Angeles Sparks held off a second-half comeback to beat the Chicago Sky 88-84 on Saturday night.

The Sky had closed within two points in the final minute, but Milton-Jones' free throws with 10.6 seconds left gave the Sparks an 86-82 lead.

Four teammates also hit double figure as Los Angeles (7-10) snapped a four-game losing streak.

Chicago (9-11) nearly erased a 20-point deficit behind 12 second-half points from Epiphanny Prince and 10 from Sylvia Fowles. Both finished with 16 points, while Erin Thorn scored 17 off the bench.

Tina Thompson had 14 points for Los Angeles and Jantel Lavender added 13. Kristi Toliver chipped in 12.

The Sparks used a 23-7 run in the final 6:57 of the first half to open a 51-36 lead. Thompson had two early 3-pointers, but had reduced minutes after collecting three first-quarter fouls.

Los Angeles pushed the lead to 20 in the third quarter following Toliver's two free throws. Chicago cut it to 68-66 as Thorn hit consecutive 3-pointers, but Los Angeles extended the lead before one final push trimmed it to 84-82 with 20 seconds left on Thorn's fifth 3-pointer.

The Sparks won for just the third time in 12 games and travel to Indiana on Sunday.

The Sparks line-up is filled with some all-time WNBA leaders in career points. Tina Thompson, the only player to have played all 14 previous seasons, tops the list with 6,743 points. Sparks forward DeLisha Milton-Jones comes in at 10th with 4,848 total points.

Guard Ticha Penicheiro ranks first in all-time assists (2,556) and second in steals (756). The Portugal native is in her 14th WNBA season.

DMJ's MILESTONES

- DeLisha Milton-Jones has been going back-and-forth with Tulsa's Sheryl Swoopes on the WNBA's career scoring chart, and she currently ranks 10th with 4,848 points.
- She recently passed Mwadi Mabika for second all-time on the Sparks career scoring list (3,663).
- This season, DMJ also passed Yolanda Griffith for fifth-most steals in WNBA history (550)

CLOSE CALLS

22 of the Sparks' 33 games have been decided by 10 or fewer points, with Los Angeles going 11-11 over that span. Thirteen of those games have been at STAPLES Center, where things have been incredibly tight, decided by an average of 6.3 points per tilt and the Sparks going 7-6.

WELL REPRESENTED ON ALL-TIME LIST

At halftime of the July 23 All-Star Game in San Antonio the WNBA unveiled its Top-15 Players of all-time, and among the honorees are four Sparks: Lisa Leslie, Tina Thompson, Ticha Penicheiro and Teresa Weatherspoon. Four other players who have donned the purple, gold and teal – Chamique Holdsclaw, DeLisha Milton-Jones, Taj McWilliams-Franklin and Candace Parker – were included in the group of 30 nominees, giving the Sparks more representatives than any other WNBA team.

SPARKS SEASON NOTES

- The Sparks lead all WNBA teams in three-point field goal percentage (.395)
 - The WNBA is .409, set by New York in 2010
 - The Sparks are on pace to break the franchise record for three-point field goal percentage in a season of .379, set in 2004 (157/414)
- The Sparks also rank fourth in field goal percentage (.446) and fourth in free-throw percentage (.796)
- By going 21-for-21 from the charity stripe on July 17, the Sparks set a new franchise record for made free-throws in a game without a miss
 - LA's previous best was 15-for-15 achieved on several occasions, most recently against the Seattle Storm on August 21, 2010
 - Kristi Toliver recorded a career-high in free throws made and attempted by going 8-for-8 from the line
 - On July 28, the Sparks made 10+ FT's without a miss for the second time this season
- On July 17 vs. Washington, the Sparks held their opponent to 25 first-half points for the second time this season
 - On June 19 the Sparks also held the Seattle Storm to 25 points
- The Sparks' 43 rebounds on July 12 at San Antonio were a season-high
 - On August 30, the Sparks recorded a season-low 21 rebounds against Seattle
- Los Angeles features two of the WNBA's eight most accurate three-point shooters
 - Jenna O'Hea ranks second at .444 while Kristi Toliver comes in at eighth with .423
- Jantel Lavender's 25 points and August 12 against Phoenix were the best single-game totals by a Sparks rookie since Candace Parker in 2008
 - Her 12 rebounds on Sept. 9 vs. Tulsa were also the most by a Sparks frosh in over three years
- On July 9, Tina Thompson came off the bench for just the second time in her WNBA career (previously on July 17, 2008 while with Houston)
 - She has started 430 of her WNBA-record 432 regular season games
 - On July 18, Thompson was held scoreless for the first time in her career
- Guard Kristi Toliver has already notched double-digit scoring totals 16 times this season, passing her total of 12 from 2010
 - Her 28 point performance on June 26 in New York set a new personal best
 - Toliver's eight assists on July 12 established a new career-high
- Ebony Hoffman had her best game as a Spark on July 26, scoring 24 points on 10-for-11 shooting vs. Minnesota
 - It was her highest scoring total since a 24-point outburst vs. Lynx on Aug. 13, 2009 while a member of the Indiana Fever
- Milton-Jones saw her streak of 37 consecutive made free-throws dating back to last season end on July 5 in Phoenix
 - Lisa Leslie sank a team-record 46 consecutive free throws (7/9-7/25/2000)
 - The WNBA record (66) was set by Cleveland Rockers forward Eva Nemcova (06/14/1999 - 06/05/2000)
- Ticha Penicheiro's 23 points on August 9 against Tulsa were her most since also scoring 23 on June 6, 2002 while a member of the Sacramento Monarchs.
 - Penicheiro is 13-for-28 from beyond the arc in 2011, after making only 2-of-18 three-pointers over the past two seasons combined
 - By notching 15 points and 10 boards on Aug. 28 at Seattle, Penicheiro amassed her first double-double in those two categories since her rookie season of 1998
- With 19,376 votes, Candace Parker was selected as a Western Conference starter for the 2011 WNBA All-Star Game, but missed the game due to injury
- Parker earned WNBA Western Conference Player of the Week for games played Monday, August 15 through Sunday, August 21.
 - The Sparks' center/forward tied for second in the Western Conference in scoring with 18.5 ppg while helping Los Angeles to a 2-2 mark on the week.
 - The Naperville, IL native recorded her fifth double-double of the season (15 points, 10 rebounds) in a narrow loss to the Dream. She then tallied 18 points, six boards and five assists in a 75-70 win over the East-leading Indiana Fever and another 18 points and 8 rebounds in a loss at Minnesota. Parker closed out her week by leading the Sparks past the Tulsa Shock, 73-67, with a game-high 23 points, nine rebounds and two steals.
- The Sparks are the only WNBA team to have two rookies notch double-doubles this season
 - On August 12, center Jantel Lavender's 25 points and 10 rebounds gave the Cleveland native her first WNBA double-dip of the season.
 - Lavender's second double-double came against the Shock on Sept. 9 by totaling 19 points and a career-best 12 rebounds.
 - Guard/forward Jenna O'Hea buried four shots from beyond the arc and established a new career-high in and total rebounds (11) while notching her first double-double on July 18

**HEAD COACH
JOE BRYANT**

Joe “Jellybean” Bryant is in his second tour of duty as a member of the Sparks’ coaching staff, and assumed head coaching responsibilities on July 10 for the remainder of the 2011 season. He holds a 39-23 (.629) career coaching record with Los Angeles.

Bryant first joined the Sparks in 2005 as an assistant coach, and was promoted to head coach over the final five games of that campaign. He made an immediate impact as the team posted a 4-1 record over that span and qualified for the Western Conference Semifinals.

The following year, Los Angeles finished atop the Western Conference at 25-9 – the second-best record in the league – and reached the Conference Finals. Bryant was at the helm of the Sparks as Lisa Leslie earned her third and final WNBA MVP award in 2006.

Before returning to Los Angeles prior to the 2011 season, Bryant served as head coach of Ruru Kamuy Hokkaido, a Japanese first division men’s team, and taught at a private basketball academy in Japan. Since 2006 he’s also held head coaching positions with the Tokyo Apache and Italy’s Sebastiani Rieti. Bryant’s coaching experience began as an assistant coach at his alma mater, LaSalle University in 1993, and continued with head coaching positions in the American Basketball Association (Las Vegas Rattlers and Boston Frenzy) and in the Slamball league.

In 1975, Bryant was the 14th overall selection in the NBA Draft by Golden State Warriors and was traded before the season to his hometown Philadelphia 76ers, where he played three seasons. Bryant headed back to the West Coast when he was traded by the 76ers to the San Diego Clippers, for whom he played from 1980-82. After a final NBA season with the Houston Rockets in 1983, Bryant continued his career in Italy for eight years in both the A1 and A2 Leagues.

Bryant and his wife Pam have two daughters, Sharia and Shayla, while their son Kobe has led the Los Angeles Lakers to five NBA Championships in his 15-year NBA career.

ASSISTANT COACH SANDY BRONDELLO

A fresh face on the Sparks’ coaching staff is Sandy Brondello, who boasts 11 total years of WNBA experience as a player and coach and has also competed internationally at the highest levels.

Brondello comes to Los Angeles after serving as the San Antonio Silver Stars’ head coach in 2010, guiding them to a Western Conference Semifinal berth. Previously she served as an assistant in San Antonio for five years (2005-2009), helping the team earn its first Western Conference Championship and trip to the WNBA Finals in 2008.

A WNBA veteran, she played five seasons with the Seattle Storm (2003), Miami Sol (2001-02) and the Detroit Shock (1998-99), averaging 11.4 points and 2.3 assists in 155 career games. Brondello played in the inaugural WNBA All-Star Game in 1999, and ranks fourth in league history with her 41.0% career three-point percentage.

The native Australian played for the Australia National Team for 18 years and is a four-time Olympian. She is a two-time silver medalist (2000 and 2004) and took home a bronze medal at the 1996 Olympics in Atlanta. She also represented Australia at the 1988 Olympics, while in 1992 Brondello was named the Australian International Player of the Year. She helped Australia bring home the bronze medal from both the 1998 and 2002 FIBA World Championships and also competed at the 1994 and 1990 World Championships and the 1990 Goodwill Games.

Prior to playing in the WNBA, Brondello played in the Women’s National Basketball League (WNBL) in Australia from 1986-96, earning league MVP acclaim in 1995. She also played in Germany for BTV Wuppertal from 1992-2002, helping the team win 10 German Cup Championships. In 1996, Brondello was named the European Cup MVP after leading Wuppertal to the European Cup title and earned three European Cup All-Star selections in 1994, 1996 and 1997.

Brondello earned a degree in teaching from the University of Western Sydney in 1990. She and Lange have a four-year-old son, Brody Max Lange, and welcomed Jayda Grace Lange to their family on May 31, 2010.
